BUSINESS and NONINSTRUCTIONAL OPERATIONS

Pupil Fees, Fines and Charges

It is the Governing Board's desire that all materials and supplies necessary for students' participation in the educational program are made available to them. No student shall be required to pay any fees, deposits, or other charges for participation in an educational activity which is a fundamental component of the district's educational program

As necessary, the Board may approve fees, deposits, and other charges which are specifically authorized by law and as outlined in Board Procedure 3260. When establishing and assessing these fees, deposits, and charges, the district shall consider students' and parents/guardians' ability to pay

Whenever a student or parent/guardian believes that an impermissible fee, deposit, or other charge is being required, the student or his/her parent/guardian may file a complaint with the principal or designee using the district's Uniform Complaint Procedure (Education Code 49013).
