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**BUSINESS AND NONINSTRUCTIONAL OPERATIONS**

**First Aid**

- I. Each teacher is provided with a first aid kit containing the first aid instructions and approved materials. Remember that the teacher and the health aide may give only first aid and no treatment.
  - A. All minor first aid is to be done by the teacher in the classroom whenever possible.
  - B. All eye injuries, foreign bodies in the eye, head injuries, and/or injuries other than minor bruises or abrasions are to be referred to the nurse's office.
  - C. In the event of a major injury, *do not move the child*. Immediately call emergency services and then notify the parents. Remember that the child is primarily the parents' responsibility and leave the decisions as to the child's care to the parent whenever practical.
  - D. No ill or injured child should be sent home without consulting the health aide or, in his/her absence, the school office.
  - E. Medications (as aspirin, etc.) are never given to the child except on written permission of the parent and written orders of a physician. The nurse or health aide will be responsible for setting up the procedures for dispensing medication.
