**BUSINESS AND NON-INSTRUCTIONAL OPERATIONS**

**Pupil Conduct on School Busses**

Rules for Safe Bus Riding

These regulations apply at all times when children are riding on a school bus. This includes field trips and all special trips. It is the responsibility of all school personnel, parents and the children themselves to see that these regulations are followed:

- A. Riders should arrive at the bus stop on time, but not too early, normally five minutes before the scheduled bus arrival.
- B. Riders should stand in a safe place and wait quietly for the bus.
- C. Riders should enter the bus in an orderly manner and take their seats.
- D. Riders shall follow the instructions and directions of the bus driver who is the person in authority and must be obeyed.
- E. Riders should stay in their seats until time to leave the bus.
- F. Riders should be courteous to the driver and to fellow passengers.
- G. There should be no noise or behavior that will distract the driver's attention from driving. This means no loud talking, laughing, yelling, singing or whistling.
- H. No part of the body, hands, arms, or head may be put out the window. Nothing may be thrown from the bus.
- I. Riders shall help keep the bus and the areas around the bus stop clean and show respect for the property of other people.
- J. No animals or insects will be allowed on the bus.
- K. Riders should be alert for traffic when leaving the bus.
