Widespread Rewards and Recognition

A reward system is an outgrowth of the basic beliefs that:

- A. All students can be successful.
- B. Acknowledging success is central to creating a sense of efficacy.
- C. A sense of efficacy relates to achievement.
- D. Student success leads to better performance and achievement.
- E. Recognition leads to pro-social behavior.
- F. Success leads to student attachment to school and significant relationship with others due to a supportive environment.

The Cambrian District Board of Trustees recognizes the importance of recognizing students for their accomplishments, and directs the schools and staffs of the district to establish a widespread rewards and recognition system for students in the Cambrian District schools. The system should offer many opportunities both in the classroom and on a school wide basis for students to be honored for their efforts and performance in academics as well as their contributions to the school.
