**Student Substance Abuse**

The Board of Trustees is committed to providing an academic environment that is free from alcohol, tobacco and other drugs which adversely affects a student's ability to achieve. Every effort will be made to reduce the chances that students will begin or continue the use of alcohol, tobacco and other drugs. A comprehensive prevention program has been developed which includes instruction from grades K-8 to meet the needs of students at their respective grade levels, as well as intervention, recovering student support, and enforcement/discipline. All Board policies, regulations, and school rules related to this prevention program shall be clearly communicated.

Recognizing that keeping schools free of alcohol, tobacco and other drugs is a common concern to the district and community, the Board supports cooperation among schools, parents/guardians, law enforcement and other appropriate community organizations involved in preventing alcohol, tobacco and other drug abuse.
