STUDENT

Immunization of Pupils

No person shall be admitted as a pupil of this District unless he/she has been fully immunized against diphtheria, pertussis (whooping cough), tetanus, poliomyelitis, measles, mumps, rubella, and Hepatitis B (prior to entering kindergarten and 7th grade) in the manner and with immunizing agents approved by the state department. (cf. 5111 - Admission)

A person who has not been fully immunized against one or more of these diseases may be conditionally admitted if the immunizations are in progress, and time lines are followed.

Immunization shall not be required for admission if the parents or guardian of a minor file with the Board a letter or affidavit stating that such immunization is contrary to his or her religious beliefs.

If the parents or guardian file with the Board a written statement by a licensed physician to the effect that the physical condition of the child is such, or medical circumstances relating to the child are such, immunization is not considered safe, indicating the specific nature and probable duration of the medical condition or circumstances which contraindicate immunization, such person shall be exempt from the requirement of immunization to the extent indicated by the physician's statement.
