Survey Results

- Went over the survey results and the results were very positive! 131 responded, most of the responders were moms.
- One of our target groups is the people who have free and reduced lunch, but we did not get as many responses from this group.
- A lot of these numbers are up from last year and we didn't have any strong dips from last year.
- A larger percentage of parents have a hard time helping with math vs reading.
- Overall, parents were more positive toward Eureka this year.
- We talked about how difficult independent studies are for Eureka math, as kids are missing the bulk of the lesson and parents get confused as they are unsure of the directions/strategies taught in class.
- Parents feel that Farnham needs a little sprucing up on the outside.
- Eureka math is looked upon more favorably this year :)
- Talked about our homework policy and how as a school (and a district) we are giving less homework to kids.

*Clarify the meaning for the question "My student needs more support with his/her homework." Strongly agree and strongly disagree meanings are reversed for this particular question.

- Hopefully will get to bring in a math intervention for 2nd grade next year.
- As far as technology - parents are concerned about their kids being on technology too much.
- Maybe teachers should communicate more with parents about what technology they are using in the classroom

*Clarify "Technology did not have a noticeable impact" - this question needs to be reworded as it's confusing

- Parents want more enrichment activities after school.
