Welcome - Jill Brigham (President)

- Called the meeting to order at 7:03pm.
- Guest Speaker is Janet Borrison from the District.

Approval of October 13, 2020 Minutes - Janissa Dayrit (Secretary)

President's Comments

- Hospitality put up "Teacher Appreciation" banners and provided a luncheon for teachers to let them know the community supports them. Hoping to host another lunch soon.
- Beautification is hoping to work on planting areas in the Science Wing for a vegetable garden and outdoor teaching area. Looking for volunteers and those with an interest in gardening and/or connections to landscape work.
- Books from Fammatre's grant were out on Picture Day and will be out on the next Picture Day on November 18th. Parents, ask your students to come browse the book selection!

Price Updates - Natalie Gioco, Principal

- Natalie presented her Principal's Coffee presentation from November 5th:
 - Reopening Timeline: Grades 6-8 planning to return to a Hybrid school plan on January 25, 2021.
 - Hybrid Schedule: Students would be on campus 2 days per week (Mon/Th or T/Fr) and asynchronous 3 days per week.
 - Students will be split up into a Cohort. There will be 2 Cohorts that will group students by last name. Cohorts will not be flexible. Cohort A = A-L and Cohort B = M-Z.
 - Student schedules might be changed, but we are working to minimize those changes.
 - Campus will look different: signs and social distancing markings, classroom layout to ensure distancing, face coverings/masks, plexiglass barriers, etc.
 - Arrival and departure will have designated gates for coming and going, health screening, no volunteers on campus during the school day.
 - Students will be able to hang out with friends at brunch/lunch, but it will be distanced and spread out.
 - Hand sanitizer provided in all classrooms, hand washing stations and restrooms available, teachers reviewing proper washing/sanitizing. Students will clean desks between classes. Teachers will clean commonly used items like door knobs, etc. Custodial staff will clean nightly.
 - PPE available in classrooms: Masks, disinfecting spray, gloves, paper towels, plexiglass.
 - HVAC and ventilation is being analyzed by an outside vendor. Windows and doors will be left open whenever possible. MERV 13 filters are being installed in all units. Filters are being replaced every 3 months.
 - Working on opening more clubs and extracurricular activities.
 - District has clear guidelines on what to do if there is a suspected or confirmed COVID-19 case.
 - Next steps: continuing to prepare the campus. HVAC, ventilation update, January 11th board meeting to confirm return to school date.

- District is staffing a full time teacher and classified employee to help back up if a Teacher needs to be out. If a teacher is well enough to work virtually from home, then an adult would be in the classroom to supervise while the teacher is on Zoom.
- District will be sending a letter to families around November 16th to choose which program their student would like.
- Natalie will work on a clearer version of a Virtual school schedule vs a Hybrid program.

Treasurer's Report - Judy Cubiss

- Not much change in budget, we have about \$2,000 in income and \$1,000 in expenses.
- Expecting more money through CEF for the Giving Campaign.

Committee Reports

- [Giving Campaign](#) - Judy reported there is ~\$20,000 currently raised. ~\$10,000 still to come in from CEF, which would put us at about 50%.
- Family Dinner Nights - Marisa Hoff has set up Family Dinner Nights for the school year. The first few include: November 30th at Mendocino Farms - 20% will go back to Price. December will be at Desi's in Campbell and January will be at Mountain Mike's Pizza.

Presentation on Cambrian School District's Land Development Proposal - Janet Borrison

- Janet is on the School Board and also a Cambrian parent.
- ["Support our Student"](#) initiative for land development.
- Budget shortfalls over the last few years has the District looking for other sources of revenue.
- Enrollment has been going down too, so we need to find other revenue.
- The proposal is to redevelop the under-utilized Metzler property. Looking to redevelop a portion of this site, but to do so requires the city to re-zone it to Residential (RN). Working with Robson Homes to develop some home ideas to enhance the neighborhood and be revenue-generating for Cambrian.
- Asking the Cambrian community to [sign a letter of support](#) to the City of San Jose. We want to show the City that the community supports the project.
