Treasurer's Report - Judy Cubiss

- We've raised ~\$35,000 for the Giving Campaign. We haven't spent what we've raised. Cash balance is up
- Student Discretionary Fund was adjusted based on the Price T-Shirts and the student in need
- Only ~\$3,500 in expenses from the teachers. They know about the stipends and Natalie will put out another reminder
- We've talked about also trying to pre-pay some things like software subscriptions, if possible

- We're in the 2nd Semester. Still working toward a hybrid return to campus, getting safety measures in place, have started implementing employee testing
- Doing more outreach to students to re-engage them
- Kindness Week this week
- We're prepping for the 21-22 School Year already. Working on materials for students to sign up for Electives. Online signups will help guide the Master Schedule. Counselors will be meeting with classrooms.

- We're in a difficult situation and all students are missing out on or have missed out on something since last March. We're eager to help students experience things like Science Camp (for next year's 6th graders who missed it this year, 5th Gr), but there are logistics that need to be looked into and it is a very large undertaking given the number of students
