

Price HSC Meeting
November 12, 2019
Meeting Notes

- I. Welcome - Jill Brigham - call to order at 7:02 pm
 - A. 14 parents present
- II. Approval of October 8, 2019 Minutes - Christine Kouvaris
 - A. Motion by Tracy Stamp to approve minutes, second by Shayne Santos, all in favor, approved.
- III. Price Updates - Natalie Gioco
 - A. Local Control and Accountability Plan
 1. ELA Standard scores - see ongoing trend with upward trend from grade 5 to 6 to 7, and then a downward trend from grade 7 to 8, consistent year over year as they track each group of students
 2. Math scores continue to grow upwards over time from grade 6 to 8
 3. Social/Emotional/Behavior Change over time - will see an increase in referrals in 2019-2020 because they are now giving those during brunch and lunch, whereas before it was only given during class time. Trying to reduce suspensions.
 4. Habitudes program - programs are being done monthly in social studies class to work on social/emotional topics.
 5. They will continue to monitor data for all students.
 6. During school there are supports and also after school supports (Imagine learning, homework club)
 7. Looking to bring in after school support for ELA like there is for math
 - B. Update on Facilities on Campus
 1. The school facilities are declining at the school site and the administration is working with facilities staff to make repairs.
 2. 180 chromebooks hit their life span in June, which were replaced this year
 3. There are another 280 chromebooks that will hit the end of life span at the end of this school year
 4. Looking to be 1.5:1, right now the school is operating at 2:1 use ration
 5. Currently have 438 chromebooks; in order to get to 1.5:1, would need 700+ chromebooks.

- B. The Board is going to add a 3D cart store on the website, so that Starting Arts registration and ticket sales can be done online. The Board approved up to \$500 for the purchase of the 3D cart store.
 - C. Color Guard - has a tarp that they put out for their performances. They requested if HSC can support this purchase. Last year only \$2500 of \$7500 in the sports budget line item was used; they will use this category to buy this item, which costs \$1500.
