Donation is tax deductible, accept company matching too

HSC is a non-profit entity

Any checks already written (for GC) that are not earmarked for grade level, send Chevonne e-mail for grade credit.

Coin challenge starts 9/1, jugs outside front office, fill with pennies, silver coins get deducted from grades total, can put silver in other jugs

Top grade levels K-2, 3-5 receive afternoon movie

Also individual student can fill water/soda bottle with only dimes equals \$100, will receive a free Sartorette T-shirt

Farmigo supports local farmers, companies

Each order is put together for the individual ordering

Can choose a Monday or Wednesday pick up

Volunteer coordinator get 30% discount
