Magnet school – home district needs to release you there before Cambrian can accept. If there are more kids that spots then numbers are drawn. No special day class, will have resource specialists, speech available. Maker spaces only at Steindorf, no band program, sports programs are still undecided (trying to be creative with solutions). Project based learning – extends where kids are at learning level to make sure kids are prepared to meet high school requirements. Follow board policy regarding homework. Homework should be purposeful, appropriate for grade level. Science Camp will be available (5<sup>th</sup> grade) Camp Campbell. How will kids do transitioning to a traditional high school? Working with high schools to work on needs of STEAM kids. School fencing will match other campuses. Will have PE, Motor Skills (unsure), Art Vistas (no) will be bringing in art more inline with STEAM. Will have a science teacher and science lab.
