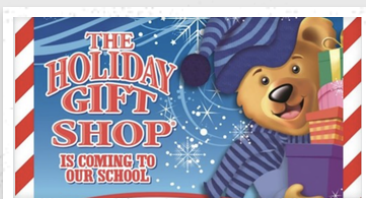

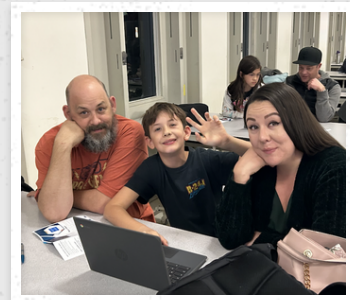
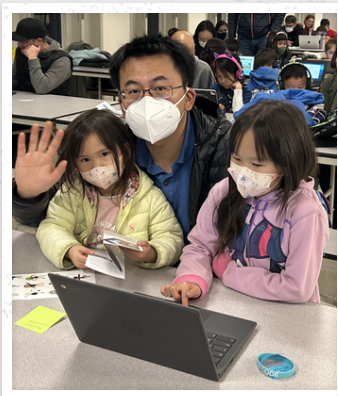
## FAMOUS AUTHOR VISITS SARTORETTE 2ND GRADERS
