Covid Tests


Report Cards

NOTE ABOUT COVID-19 RAPID TESTS

PLEASE NOTE:

The California Department of Public Health endorses the emergency use of over-the-counter COVID-19 Tests beyond their FDA authorized expiration. This blanket extension, subject to appropriate internal control development* during testing, is valid until CDPH posts that the emergency extension has ended, at which point participants should cease using tests beyond their printed expiration dates. The emergency extension applies to all FDA authorized over-the-counter COVID-19 tests, including:

- · Abbott BinaxNOWTM COVID-19 Antigen Self-Test
- AccessBio CareStartTM COVID-19 Antigen Home Test
- ACON FlowflexTM COVID-19 Antigen Home Test
- iHealthTM COVID-19 Antigen Rapid Test
- On/GoTM COVID-19 Antigen Self-Test

*The internal control line after test development should be both easily visible and the color specified by the specific test instructions

MAKERSPACE

There has been a lot of creativity in MakerSpace the last couple of weeks, the kids are having a great time!

Last week students made mobiles of things they are grateful for. They had a sheet the filled out or drew pictures and decorated. Then they had a variety of materials they could use to decorate them with: feathers, beads, pipe cleaners, colored tape and yarn.

This week in the MakerSpace was a challenge week. Students worked in groups of three and had the task of building a chute to slide acorns down and into a cup. The constraints they had were the following:

- -use a cup to catch the acorn
- -use the whole acorn (no taking the top off)
- -use the foam insulation as part of the chute
- -may not tape to the table

Then they had blue tape, cups, small boxes, cardboard tubes & egg cartons to build their chutes. They spent time planning, built and then demonstrated their chutes for the class. They then dismantled them and put supplies back to be ready for the next class. There was lots of

ingenuity and creativity. Thank you to all who donated supplies for our last two projects. After the break students will have free making again so please keep the donations coming!


