

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## FOLLOW RULES FOR SARTORETTE'S PARKING LOT

1. Parking lot spaces are for staff only.
2. Park on the street to walk children to/from school.
3. For DRIVE THRU, use RIGHT LANE for student DROP OFF/PICK UP. **Pull all the way forward.** Students efficiently exit/enter on the car's right side only to/from sidewalk. Use LEFT LANE as PASSING LANE.
