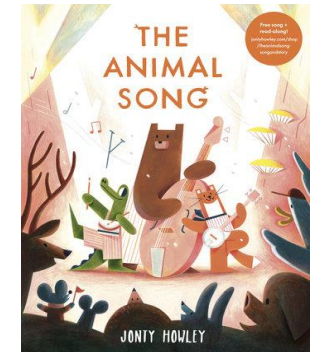


Year 1 had a fantastic Space Dome experience on Wednesday, exploring the planets in our Solar System.
