Lockout

Outside

A lockout involves a possible threat *outside* the school buildings.

Students In the Building

When a lockout is put into effect, all of the students are moved into the school buildings.

School Doors

Perimeters are secured, doors into the schools are locked. Visitors are buzzed in and screened before entering, almost no different than on any school day.

Classes Continue

Indoor classes and activities continue as normal, like on any other school day.

Lockdown

Inside

A lockdown involves a possible threat *inside* the school buildings.

Students in the Classroom

When a lockdown is in effect, students are moved into a secure indoor location, usually a classroom.

Classroom Doors

School hallways are cleared and all classrooms doors are locked with students inside. Students have been moved away from doors and windows - with the lights off.

Classes Stop

All indoor classes and activities stop while a lockdown is in effect.
