c. Elementary Principal's Report: Mrs. Heers

Current enrollment for the 2018-2019 school year – 282 students. Enrollment this time last year was 277 students. January highlights: Classes resumed January 7<sup>th</sup>. The Six Flags Read to Succeed Six Hour Reading Club is underway for K – 6 students. Cooke County Jr Livestock Show was held Jan 10 – 12. Elementary Awards Ceremony was held on January 11. Kinder, 1<sup>st</sup>, and 2<sup>nd</sup> were screened using the Texas Primary Reading Inventory (TPRI) CogAT was administered to Kindergarten. The “Cooke County Spelling Bee” will be held at the local level on January 30 at 1:30 p.m. in the MISD Cafetorium for students in grades 4 – 8. Emma Walterscheid was named the MISD Spelling Bee Champion. Emma Walterscheid will compete at the Cooke County Spelling Bee on February 11<sup>th</sup> at the Gainesville ISD Administration Building. January 21 – 25 participated in “No Name Calling Week”. Karen Young with the American Heart Association presented elementary students with exciting information regarding “Kids Heart Challenge” formerly known as “Jump Rope for Heart”. Cicily Waneck, 5<sup>th</sup>/6<sup>th</sup> grade Social Studies and 5<sup>th</sup> grade Reading teacher was recognized as MISD’s Jack Harvey recipient at Weatherford’s Doss Heritage and Cultural Center. Bernadette Otto, 4<sup>th</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> grade science teacher, sponsors JH TMSCA and currently has 54 students competing. Muenster Elementary School was awarded the ExxonMobil Education Alliance Grant of \$500 to support Math and Science programs.
