1. Call to Order by Board President, Steve Trubenbach @ 6:30 p.m.
2. Call roll and establish quorum

4. Comments/audience participation/recognitions – the superintendent recognized Coach Atcheson – Jack Harvey Teacher of the Year Award, Brady Carney and the State Quarter Finals MHS Football Team, and Dianne Endres, Cicily Waneck, and the Elementary UIL District Champions. FCCLA’s National Star Event Team presented the board members a token of appreciation. Joni Sturm introduced Brooke Walterscheid as president of Region II, Jori Magee who is running for state office, and National Team members Mariah Rocho and Shelby Klement.
5. Superintendent’s Report
  - **Clay Richerson** reported that enrollment is down from the start of the year. Board members Neal Flusche - Place 1 and Mel Walterscheid – Place 2 positions are up for election on May 11, 2013. Sign up will be held on January 30 through March 1, 2013, Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. in the administration office.
  - a. Elementary’ Principals Report**
    - **Lou Heers** reported an enrollment of 269 in grades PK - 6. She reported that the “Elementary UIL Awards Ceremony” was held on December 19<sup>th</sup> for the District UIL Champions with 813.5 points. She also reported on the six weeks Elementary Awards Ceremony, TPRI and CogAT testing to be held in January, FLEX Day on January 21 with a 2:00 p.m. dismissal, and the “Dallas Morning News Spelling Bee” to be held on January 23<sup>rd</sup>.
  - b. High School Principal’s Report**
    - **Sharon Browning** reported an enrollment of 200 for grades 7 – 12. She reported on a FLEX Day scheduled for January 21<sup>st</sup>. HS UIL, CX Debate, and JH & HS TMSCA are participating in practice meets in preparation for spring competition. The FFA Stock show is scheduled for January 12. Jason Atcheson is the Jack Harvey recipient for Teacher of the Year. Bret Walterscheid is Teacher of the Month for December, and Devon Brinkley and Sadie Stoffels are students of the month for December. JH won second place in District UIL.
  - c. Technology Director’s Report**
    - **Jeff Presnall** reported that the Technology Plan for 2013-14 is being developed along with next year’s E-rate funding application. The use of cost effective options such as the iPad and Chromebook will eventually replace desktop computer workstations. MISD now has 16 wireless computer connections. The cafeteria projector has been reconfigured for wired access which prevents audio/video lag problems. Laptop computers have been cleaned up and configured for use by UIL contestants.
  - d. Athletic Director’s Report**
    - **Brady Carney** reported that Cole Walterscheid and Andy Flusche received All-State honors in Varsity Football. In girls Basketball the 8<sup>th</sup> grade girls are 3-2, 7<sup>th</sup> grade girls are 5-1, JV girls are 14-7, and the Varsity Girls are 21-4. JVG and VG are 2-0 in district play. In boys’ basketball the 8<sup>th</sup> grade boys are 4-2, the 7<sup>th</sup> grade boys are 3-3, JV boys are 5-0, and Varsity Boys are 8-3. Powerlifting will begin in Whitesboro on January 19<sup>th</sup>.
