Senior Check List

- Signed up on Naviance for college admissions visits and attended visits during CAP
- Created a complete college list to "Colleges I'm Applying to" on Naviance
- Corrected on my Naviance college list the category "Applying via Common App?" so that any colleges marked "unknown" now say "yes" or "no"
- D Notified my teachers of my complete list of colleges and deadlines with at least 3 weeks notice
- Gave Mrs. Marra the parent permission slip (pink form) and a ONE TIME \$20 fee in cash or check made out to MSDA to defray the cost of Naviance
- Gave Mrs. Marra a transcript request form (found on the Portal and in her office) for each college with at least two weeks notice of college deadline
- Completed self-reported grade section for all universities requiring it

- Duploaded and submitted the final draft of essays and supplements to applications
- Sent SAT scores through <u>www.collegeboard.org</u> or ACT scores through <u>www.actstudent.org</u> if required.
- Submitted the CSS Profile for colleges that require it (available on October 1st and the list of schools are found on <u>www.collegeboard.org</u>)
- Submitted the FAFSA (available October 1st on <u>www.studentaid@edu.gov</u>)
- Signed up for Seton Hall Instant Decision Day if I meet the requirements and am interested in participating
- Meet with your counselor to discuss any questions or concerns
- Read emails and newsletters from my counselor about reminders and scholarship opportunities
- Created account on NCAA Clearinghouse for student athletes applying to DI and DII schools

Naviance

- Parents can go into Naviance and create their own account. Go to the website, scroll down to parent registration and follow directions
- Investigate scattergrams
- Supermatch/college search based on career interest survey
- Resumé
- Students match Common App account with Naviance
- Naviance edocs is how MSDA sends documents to colleges electronically

SAT/ACT Scores

• All students must send their SAT or ACT scores directly from the testing services.

• ACT at <u>www.actstudent.org</u>.

Your College List

• Reach School

-Your academic credentials fall below the school's standards.

-The school has a lower acceptance rate.

• Target School

-Your academic credentials fall within or above the school's range. -The school has an average acceptance rate.

- Safety School
 - -Your academic credentials fall above the school's range making you feel reasonably certain you will be admitted.
 - -The school has a higher acceptance rate.
- You will work with your counselor to finalize your "List". This is a very personalized and individual process, and not an exact science. If your "List" is well thought out and researched, you will certainly see a high rate of success in the decisions you receive from the colleges you have applied to.

Demonstrated Interest

- Demonstrated interest can be shown through participation in:
 - Campus visits
 - Interviews
 - Information sessions & webinars
 - Open houses
 - College fairs
 - Admissions Counselor visits at the Mount

A list of visiting colleges are posted on Naviance for students to sign-up and meet with.

Applications

 Students complete Common App or other application required by each individual college.

• Some may require additional supplemental questions.

• Students must proofread the application and essay before submitting.

Types of Application Deadlines

• Early Decision

- Can only apply to one school this way and requires a binding contract signed by student, parents, and counselor
- If you are in need of financial aid, please consider carefully because you will not be able to compare other financial aid packages.

• Early Action

• Can apply to multiple schools this way and has an early pool of applicants. Deadlines are specific to college and may vary.

• Regular

• Final deadline to receive application materials

Important Forms in Our Department

• Teacher recommendations

- Students asked <u>**2 teachers**</u> for a recommendation before summer break and give them the necessary form.
- List of college deadlines must be given to teachers. Please give teachers as much time as possible ranging from 2 weeks to 1 month.
- Students will also send request/reminder via Naviance in the fall to their recommenders.

Important Forms in Our Department

- Release of records (pink)
 - Permission for the Mount to release school documents to colleges
 - Students must include a one time fee of \$20 cash or check to help with the cost of Naviance
- Transcript release (yellow)
 - Where to send transcripts: must fill out one for <u>each</u> college applying to
 - Must be submitted at least <u>2 weeks</u> before application due date.
 - Counselor Letter and School Profile are automatically sent with transcript.

For any colleges that have application deadlines between DECEMBER DECEMBER 15 and JANUARY 15, all requests must be handed into into the counseling office to Mrs. Marra NO LATER THAN DECEMBER 1ST.

Please keep the school calendar in mind due to the holiday season as well as the potential for inclement weather

Need to Know

 Our department automatically sends first marking period and mid-year grades to each college to which the student has applied.

- **Final transcripts** will be sent automatically to the college that your daughter will be attending.
- Students must give us a copy of all acceptance letters and scholarship/grant award letters.

Statement on Missing Materials

Colleges and universities will close during the week of December 18th through January 1st...Sometimes longer! Colleges will receive thousands of applications and will spend months going through things.

Therefore, it is quite possible that you will not be able to immediately receive confirmation from the colleges regarding the receipt of your application materials. Naviance does have an electronic time stamp however, which clarifies the status of information submitted through the Naviance system.

Each college manages the process of notifying applicants of the status of their application files very differently. Many colleges will send an email or letter to students to verify that their application is complete or to let you know that something is missing. Other colleges will give applicants an account online where they can check to see what application materials have been received.

If you receive an email or letter stating that an application is incomplete because it is missing a transcript or a recommendation letter, **DON'T PANIC**. What this likely means is that they may have not officially entered your application materials in their database.

As long as materials have been submitted on time, the counseling department can always work with the colleges and universities to clarify any possible issues.

College Athletics

 Any student planning to play college athletics at the DI or DII level must:

• Register with the NCAA Clearinghouse

• Give Mrs. Marra your student account number, so she can submit final transcripts at the end of senior year.

Financial Aid

• FAFSA form can be filled out on December 1, 2023 at www.studentaid@ed.gov

• Some colleges require you to complete the CSS profile on <u>www.collegeboard.org</u>, which you can begin on October 1, 2023. A list of colleges can be found on the College Board website.

• College websites each have a Net Price Calculator.

Scholarships

- Local, institutional, and national
- Many website search engines and most applications require an essay.
- Network and use multiple resources to search.
- Student's largest scholarships come from the college itself.
- Merit scholarships are usually based on grades and test scores.

Scholarships

- Naviance Scholarship List
 - Check Naviance weekly to see scholarship list updates. Students can download directly from Naviance.
- Check Week Ahead and Counseling Newsletters for list of local scholarships.
