



Japan Service Trip: March 22-29, 2024

Mission

The Japan Service Trip is open to all TKA high school students. We will be partnering with Ito Christ Center and missionaries Peter and Jenny Oh. Our team will support the ICC ministry through various planned programs, games, activities, and outreach.

Goals

- To serve, love, and share the gospel cross-culturally with the Japanese people.
- To augment the discipleship ministry of the missionaries at Ito Christ Center.
- To encourage the Oh family.
- To help students gain a passion and vision for missions.

Itinerary

March 22	Travel to Fukuoka, Japan
March 23-27	Service activities: neighborhood evangelism, English camp, lead praise, maintenance work
March 28	Explore nearby areas with local students
March 29	Return to San Francisco

Accommodations/Food

We will be housed at Ito Christ Center where students will experience sleeping on tatami flooring with futons. All meals (breakfast, lunch, dinner) will be provided during our service days.

Cost - \$2,450

The cost for this trip covers airfare to Fukuoka and back, lodging, meals, and ministry costs. Students will have to cover the additional cost of meals in the airports as well as personal spending money.

Application Process

The Japan Service trip is open to all High School Students. To apply, please submit the 2024 Service Trip Online Application. The 2024 Service Trip Application is for current full-time students only. The link to this application will be posted on the Student Portal under the "Announcements." Applications will only be accepted during the following time frame: Thursday, September 21, through Monday, October 2. (Note: The application will no longer be available after 7:00p.m. on Monday, October 2).

Selection Process

The team will consist of a maximum of 20 students, plus 5 adult chaperones. After applications are submitted, participants will be interviewed and selected based on the following trip-specific criteria: a heart for missions, cross-cultural sensitivity, gifting, a servant's attitude, and previous service experience. The ability to speak Japanese is a plus, but not required. For the Japan Service Trip, priority will not automatically be given based on grade level. All applicants will be notified by October 31st.
