Soft Skills Key to Success in SD Postsecondary Education



Time Management

80.5% of postsecondary institutions indicate students lack skills necessary to appropriately manage time.

"There will be many due dates and assignments to manage. Budgeting your time and making sure that assignments are turned in is very important."

Problem Solving

70.1% of postsecondary institutions notice students struggle figuring out what to do when something isn't going well with a course, roommate, etc.

"Talking to your instructors, letting them know when you have a problem before an assignment is due, is much easier than after a deadline is missed."

Communication

66.2% of postsecondary institutions indicate that students don't reach out to faculty/staff when they need assistance.

"Create positive relationships with your classmates and teachers by learning how to communicate effectively in person, via email and the phone."

Organization

66.2% of postsecondary institutions notice students lack preparation in order to meet deadlines within courses.

"Your hand is not held in the real world. Learning to organize yourself and stay on task is crucial."

Perseverance

57.1% of postsecondary institutions responded that students had a hard time recovering from failing a test.

"When things get difficult, persist! Don't quit. Ask for help!"

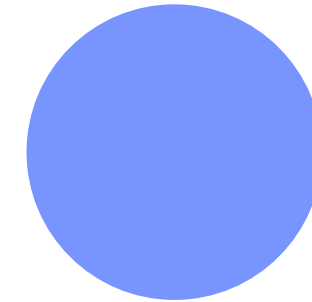
Campus Tours

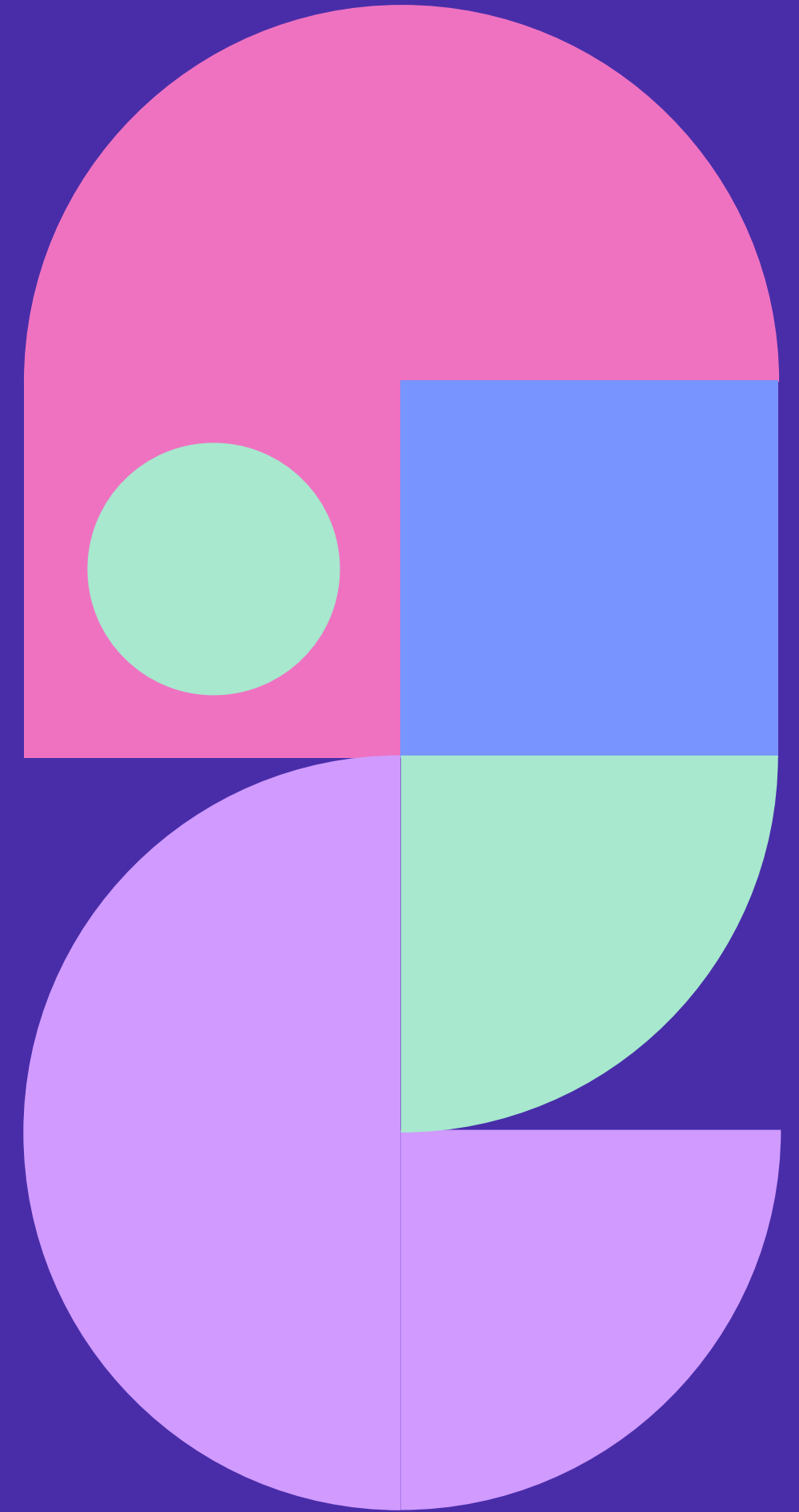

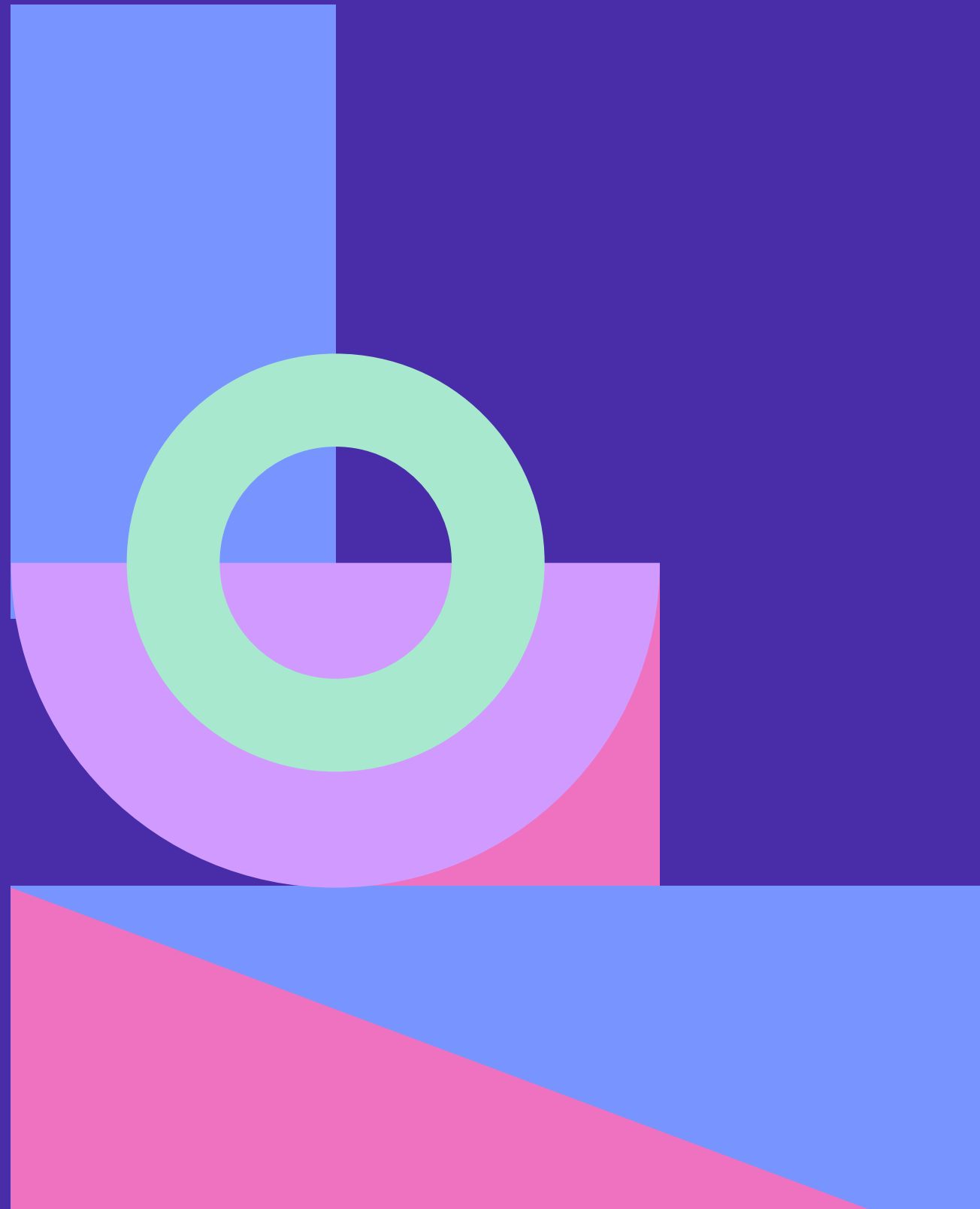

- Early Decision/Early Action/Regular Decision/Rolling Admission

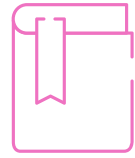


Senior Timeline



- Thanksgiving – Most colleges accept applications until Christmas, but we encourage students to turn them in around Thanksgiving.
- October 1st–November 30th – College Access Campaign (Admission fee waived to SD Schools)
- Sometime in late December – FAFSA Opens
- At least two weeks before submission date, students should request letters of recommendation if required.
- Some freshman and program scholarships are due shortly after application. Please follow the school for exact dates.
- Most scholarships are due throughout the spring, primarily in March.

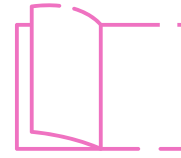

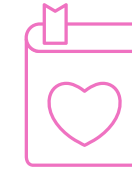

Notes on Testing

- Test Optional – Definition is unique to each institution. (Read the fine print)
 - Many waive it for admissions, but require it for scholarships
 - Most will still require placement testing when arriving on campus
- Test Blind – Do not consider scores even if submitted.
- Test flexible – Allows you to choose (ACT, AP, SAT)
- ACT Superscores



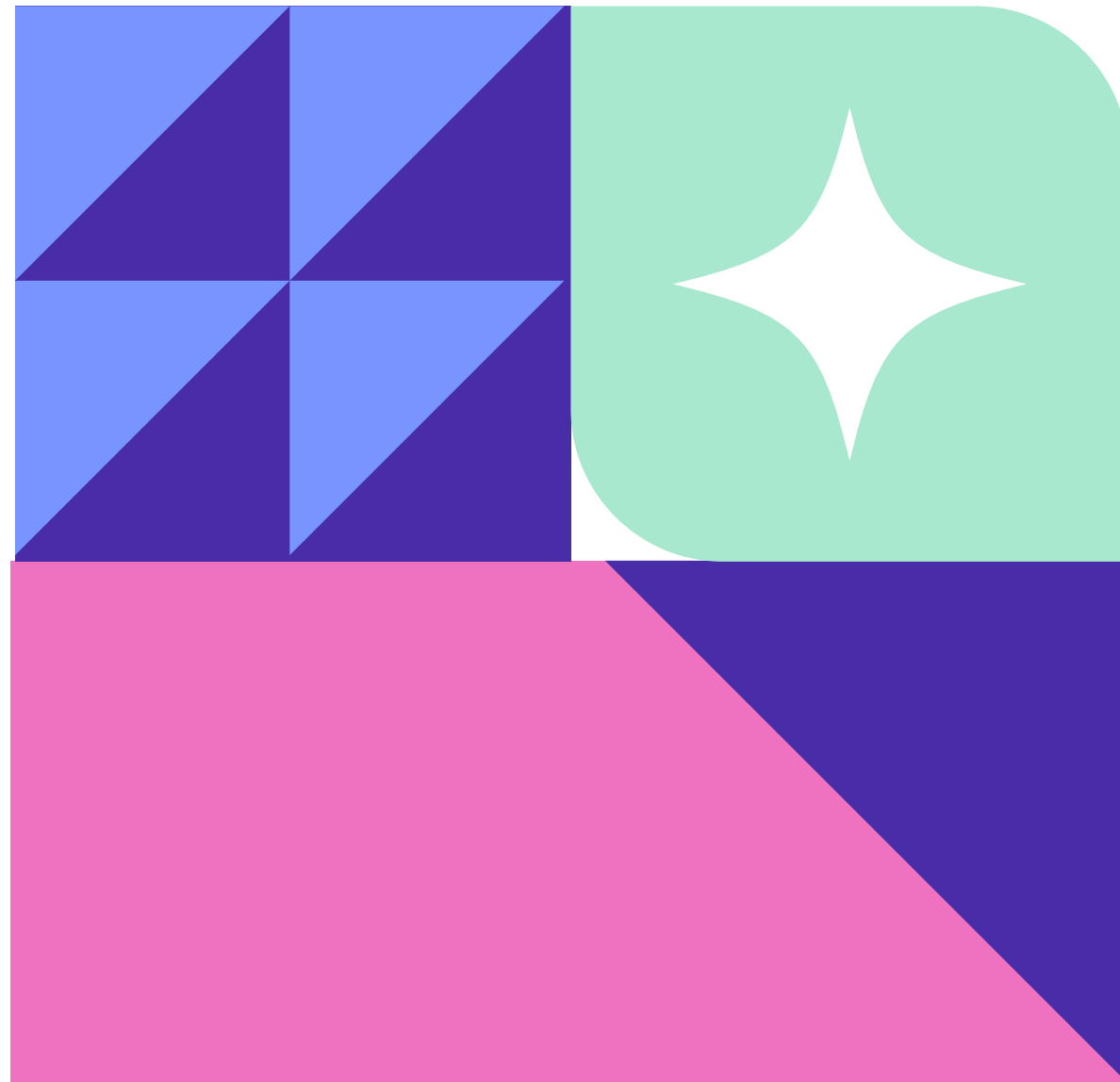

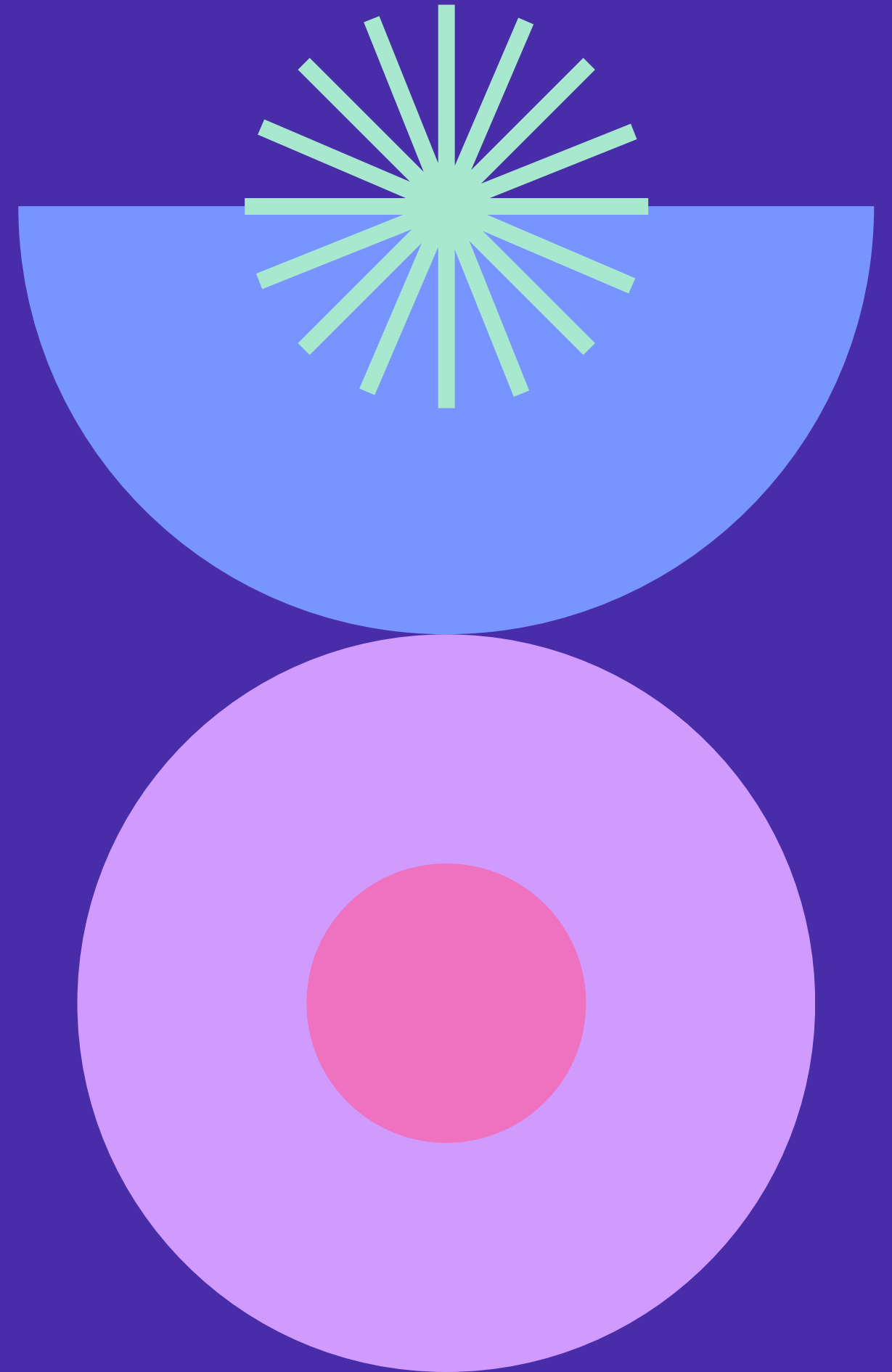

SD Opportunity Scholarship

- Super score will be allowed if on an official score report from ACT
- Requirements: Have a score of 28 or above; or a score of 24 and completion of the specified curriculum requirements with no course lower than a “C”.
- Once decision is made, fill out initial application online.

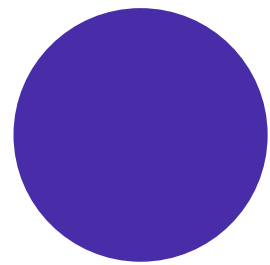
- Technical School scholarship opportunity for high demand fields.

Dakota Corps

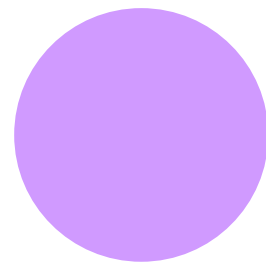
- Full ride scholarship at SDBOR school with a commitment to work in critical-need field in SD for 5 years

 - Accountant / Auditor
 - Engineer (includes all fields EXCEPT mining)
 - Information Technology
 - Registered Nurse

- Referral source for long term counseling

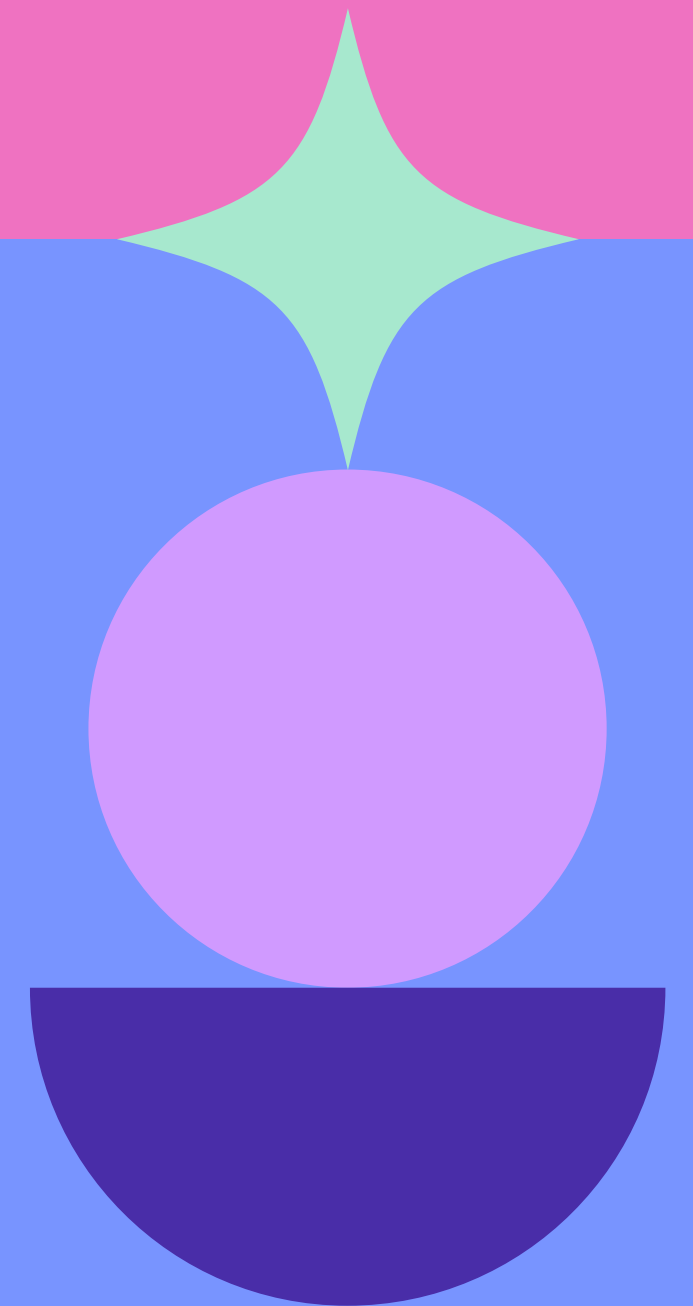

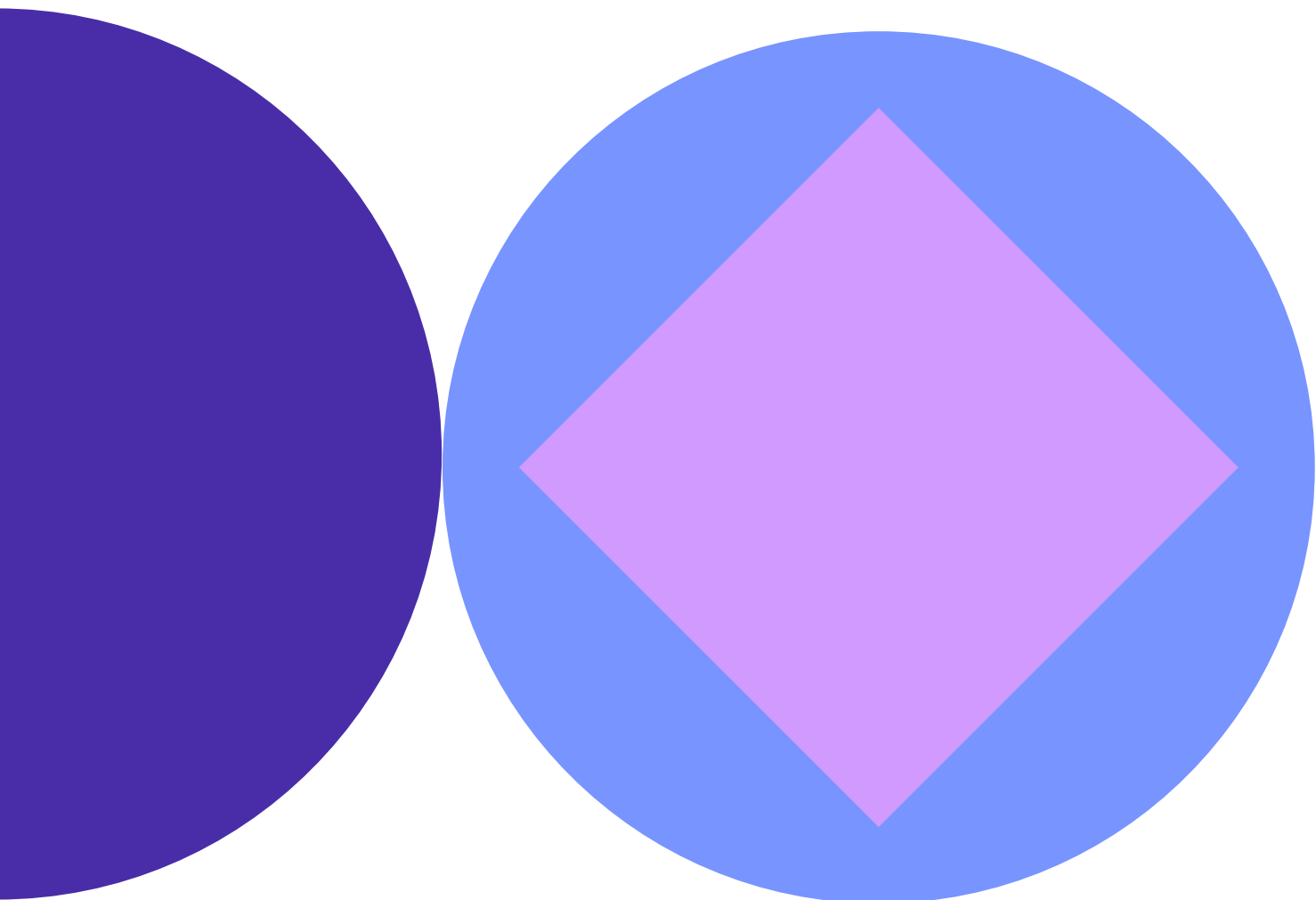
