
In an effort to remain transparent, conduct a bi-annual question and answer session regarding the financial standing of the district to better inform the community and parents of the current and projected needs.


General Fund Revenue Sources - FY23 Actual




State Foundation Revenue History



General Fund Expenditures - FY23 Actual




General Fund Expenditures - FY23 Actual


Enrollment Trends




Current School Levies

 - Last Renewed November 2020 for 10 years
 - Current effective millage 1.3
- Current Operating Expense Levy
 - Originally passed November 2013 for 5.9 mills
 - Last Renewed November 2022 for 5 years
 - Current effective millage 4.82


Effective Millage Rates

REAPPRAISAL SCENARIO

The following examples show how a 30% average increase in the property values due to reappraisal does not equate to a 30% increase in property tax. This is due to H.B. 920 which was passed in 1976 during a period of unprecendented inflation which was causing home values to soar sometimes by double-digit percentages resulting in property taxes increasing at the same alarming rates. HB 920 adjusts the outside effective millage rate to bring in the same total amount of taxes on carryover property.
