ENGAGE District 7 held four small-group work sessions to discuss the Planning Principles for Development of Improvement Plan. The presentation also included small-group work sessions to listen to ideas and suggestions related to the District’s Improvement Plan for school facilities. Approximately **117** community members and D7 staff attended the four sessions. The presentation began with a brief overview of the Engage D7 program by community co-chair, Lucas Siron. The community co-chair also gave a report on the Community Engagement Session (CES) #1 findings. Superintendent Dr. Patrick Shelton and architects from Cordogan and Clark presented an overview of District 7 facility projects, including which projects are needed, projected costs, proposed options and timelines.
