Highly Capable Program:

Nooksack Valley School District is preparing for its yearly Highly Capable Program referral window running from November 1 through December 14, 2023.

The State of Washington defines highly capable as "students who perform or show potential for performing at significantly advanced academic levels when compared with others of their age, experience or environments", as demonstrated by one or more of the multiple learning characteristics specified. The multiple characteristics focus upon (WAC 392-170-035)

If you'd like to refer your student, connect with your child's teacher to have a conversation about indicators to consider regarding your child and possible referral:

- Capacity to learn with unusual depth of understanding, to retain what has been learned, and to transfer learning to new situations.
- Capacity and willingness to deal with increasing levels of abstraction and complexity earlier than their chronological peers.
- Ability to make unusual connections among ideas and concepts.
- Ability to learn very quickly in their area(s) of intellectual strength
- Capacity for intense concentration and/or focus
- Ability to apply creative solutions to problem/challenge

Annual Student Update and Parent Square

Each year we ask parents and guardians to make sure their student's information is updated. This is done through Skyward as our Annual Student Update. The window for this update closes later in October. Without correct mailing addresses, phone numbers and contact information you will not receive report cards or other informational mailings and we may not be able to contact you in case of illness or emergency. Along with information updates, please complete the other forms and information requested each year. Please update!!

We use Parent Square for our communication home with families. You choose to set up the way in which the schools and teachers will communicate with you. It also helps us ensure we have accurate contact information. If you are not already signed up in Parent Square, please contact the Middle School office and we will help you with the process. If you have a student who has rolled up to a new school, you may need to confirm this in Parent Square, look for a pop-up. This system also allows for two-way communication regarding absences, texting to teachers, emailing etc. Our goal is to provide one communication tool for our parents and teachers for all school activities.

Updated cell phone use at school:

At NVMS our hope for students is that they are able to develop healthy peer-peer relationships both in-person and online along with healthy and productive relationships with technology. In order to do so, consistent campus and classroom expectations around cell phone and ear bud usage will be in place. If a student needs to use their phone for personal use, the expectation is that they check in with a teacher or other staff member to get permission to step into the office or separate space to do so. Students may also use the school phone for school business or emergencies.

Cell phones must remain in students' backpack between the times of 7:40-2:15., with the exception of their lunch time.

Violation of Cell Phone Expectation- (cell phone gets turned into the office)

1st time— Student will need to pick up phone at the end of the day

2nd time – Parent/Guardian will need to arrange to pick up phone Lunch Detention

3rd time— Pioneer Level Drop
