



Some of the features Mosyle Manager provides to schools are:

- Application installation
- Proxy settings and filtering access to Internet sites
- Create security profiles e.g. application control and web filters
- Rules for allowing or hiding applications during periods of time
- Allows us to easily provide troubleshooting assistance to students.
- If an iPad is lost, we can track it, lock it until it is found, and send out the signal - similar to Find my iPhone
- If a student forgets their pincode, we can reset it (as long as it has not been restarted since the iPad was blocked).
- All VPNs are blocked

Some of the features Mosyle Manager provides to schools are:

- Teachers can monitor students devices during a lesson to make sure they are on the right application
- Together with our firewall, students do not have access to inappropriate content on the web
- If students are searching for inappropriate content during school hours, it is flagged on our system
- Restriction of changes to settings applied by the school
- Configuration of Wi-Fi authentication
- Provides an extra layer of security

- Show only selected applications, setting an app curation for your child


## Features of ScreenGuide:



**ScreenGuide Parental Control app** allows you to set parental controls and configure rules for the safe, fun, and educational use of tablets and smartphones - while minimizing potential risks such as cyberbullying, inappropriate content consumption, and overexposure to screens. To set up and start managing your child's school device, just follow the steps below:

- 1** Start by downloading the ScreenGuide app on your personal device – you can look for the app on the App Store (for iOS devices), or by visiting <https://screen.guide/download>.
- 2** Enter your email to create your account.
- 3** Fill out your account info and click **"SIGN UP"**.
- 4** Click **"CREATE A FAMILY"** to continue.
- 5** Type your family name and click **"CREATE"**.

Using the browser on your child's device, access the highlighted blue link.

You will be redirected to the Mosyle Manager app - enter your ScreenGuide login credentials:



Once you login with your **ScreenGuide** account info, within the Mosyle Manager app, you'll be prompted to enter a passcode in order to connect your child's school-managed device to your **ScreenGuide** account. Enter the passcode shown here:
