


Getting Started with Chromebooks


Connecting to Wifi

When you first open the Chromebook, you'll be prompted to join your own Wifi network. You'll be asked for a password. You won't be able to log into the Chromebook without a wifi connection.




Signing into a Chromebook

When a student signs into a Chromebook, they are signing into their student Google account. Once the device is set up with an internet connection at your home, students will simply enter their s(number) and district password to log in.




Accessing built-in tutorials

Click on the wifi, battery, and time button on the bottom right of your screen. Then click on the gear icon. From there, you'll click 'About Chrome OS' and 'Get help with Chrome OS.' It will give you a screen tour, teaching you how to navigate the Chromebook. If you need to troubleshoot, see the tips [here](#).



Chrome Shortcuts

You can quickly access the Chromebook keystrokes by **Pressing Ctrl + Alt + ?** Click on the tabs on the left for additional shortcuts.



Accessing ClassLink

Open the Chrome browser and click on the 'student.k12northstar.org bookmarks' folder on the top left side of the window. A drop-down menu will appear. Click on ClassLink Launchpad. You'll be redirected to 'Sign in with Google.' Once you're in, you can access district supported software and links teachers have pushed out for student use.
