APPROVAL OF AGENDA

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Approval of February 28, 2013, minutes as amended to include Construction Academy may be receiving \$20,000.00 (under Information section), and under Reports section #4 needed a period rather than a comma. Ms. Carlson moved and Mr. Hall seconded. Changes were made and minutes posted on the FNSBSD website.

Tour of Ms. Ashlock's business enterprise class at Ben Eielson High School was provided by Mr. Gatto and Mr. Chapin (sub for Ms. Ashlock). The printing equipment was demonstrated by Mr. Chapin.

REPORTS

1. Perkins
 - a) \$80,000.00 reallocated for Fairbanks to support PLTW BioMedical and develop Business academy at Lathrop High School.
 - b) The FNSBSD's District Approved Reporting Targets (DARTS) met nine out of ten performance levels. The *Placement in Education and/or Employment* indicator was not met.
2. Construction Academy

- a) Mr. Hall and Mr. Cheap are working toward adding a Middle School Construction Awareness workshop during the summer.
3. Youth First application was submitted.
 - a) Mr. Hall included the STA agreements and included the career guides, and hopes to include a career guide under the Perkins grant.
4. School to Apprenticeship (STA)
 - a) Ironworkers agreement was approved. Students were accepted into the different unions (Plumbers & Pipefitters, Carpenters, & Electricians).
5. CTE Curriculum report was provided by Ms. Carlson.
 - a) The Perkins 5-year curriculum revision cycle is ending.
 - b) Two curricula were adopted (Architecture and Health Science) this year.
 - c) The curriculum department is reviewing by career cluster. Sample programs of study were developed as well.
 - d) The school board will be approving future revisions as the curriculum department provides them.
 - e) Nine new classes have been approved. Every school in the district has at least one new class.
 - f) Some classes were moved to align with Common Career and Technical Core standard.
 - g) Mr. Deutsch provided information about the Pre-apprenticeship at Ben Eielson High School. There are placements currently on Eielson Air Force Base through the pre-apprenticeship agreement. Ft. Wainwright is contemplating the pre-apprenticeship agreement. The curriculum revision contains a pre-apprenticeship in all high schools.
 - h) Mr. Hall provided two handouts: 1) Career and Technical Education Programs of Study (CTEPS) and Personal Learning and Career Plans (PCLP) document and 2) Pathways to Bright Futures.
