**REPORTS**

1. Mr. Daley spoke about the Math-in-CTE and WorkKeys, which employers use to identify applicants. Mr. Daley developed some Math-in-CTE lesson plans and used them in his class. He mentioned the Applied Math section in WorkKeys and using some practice assignments in his class. He took the WorkKeys himself. The district is reviewing the WorkKeys and identifying ways to help students as the WorkKeys are administered.
2. Perkins-funded Professional Development is essential to the district as teachers need current training, which requires out of state travel.
3. Construction Academy's last workshop, Scaffold User and Forklift Driver, was held April 2-4 with 7 students obtaining certifications. Construction Academy was provided with \$10,000.00 more and will use

it for the Middle School Construction Awareness workshop on June 3-7, 2013. Mr. Cheap will provide a flyer for ease of advertising to parents and students.

4. Youth First application was submitted. Ms. Carol Schumacher and Ms. Barbara Robinson stopped in Fairbanks on their way to Barrow for a check in meeting.

5. CTE Curriculum update: Ms. Hadaway stated that on Tuesday the school board should sign off on the curriculum. This summer, Curriculum department will be working on the middle school CTE curriculum. Once the curriculum is approved then it goes into the portal with the SOA.
