

- Maintained in person learning for all grade levels for the entire 21/22 school year.
- Implemented Lexia as our new intervention strategy for low readers in middle school.
- Collaborated with Tanana Chiefs Conference and UAF College of Business and Securities Management to offer Career Explorers Class.
- Collaborated with Doyon Foundation to offer AK Native Language class utilizing Doyon Languages Online platform.
