

Data Dashboard Quick Facts

- 1) Enrollment decrease of 12.7% between 02-03 and 19-20 (15,140 to 13,219).
- 2) Average proficiency rate from 16-17 to 18-19 on State assessments:
English Language Arts 43.0%, Math 40.1%, and Science 51.8%
- 3) District proficiency rate consistently higher than State proficiency rate on PEAKS (competitive versus the Big4 – Anchorage, Juneau, Kenai, and Mat-Su).
- 4) District performance on MAP is about the national average for Reading and below the national average for Math (NCE of 50 is average, or 80% Tier1).
- 5) District growth on MAP is below average for both Reading and Math, with the exception of 2017-2018 (NCE of 50 or Tier1% of 80 is national average).
- 6) Graduation Rates have increased between 2010-11 and 2018-19 from 73.6% to 80.7%.
- 7) Dropout Rates in grades 7-12 have reduced by almost half between 2006-07 and 2018-19 from 6.5% to 3.5%.
- 8) Greater than ¾ of students and staff indicated a “positive” or “very positive” school climate in Engagement, Safety, and Environment.
- 9) Discipline rates have decreased from 12.5% to 8.7% in 2007-08 to 2018-19.
- 10) Average attendance rate between 06-07 and 18-19 is about 92.6% per school year.
