

COBIS Music Festival 2024 – In-person Event Terms and Conditions

The COBIS Music Festival (in-person event) will take place from 9-11 February 2024 at British School of Bahrain.

Participants

- The COBIS Music Festival is open to COBIS member schools. Each school with a registered COBIS account should participate as an individual school.
- Students in Years 6-13 can attend the Music Festival 2024.
- Those in Years 6-9 must enter the 'Lower School' categories and those in Years 10-13 must enter the 'Upper School' categories.
- Participating schools are permitted to bring up to 20 students to the Festival.

Registration

- Schools must register for the in-person Festival via the online form on the COBIS website.
- All bookings must be made by school staff.
- The cost per participant (student or teacher) is £170. In addition to this, each attending school will be charged a COBIS registration fee of £319.
- The participation fee covers competition entry, musical workshops, catering, and transport within the host country (transfers between the airport and accommodation, and the accommodation and event venues). Travel to/from Bahrain, and accommodation within Bahrain is **not** included in this fee.
- The closing date for registration is Thursday 26 October 2023.
- Places will be allocated on a first come-first served basis. If the number of registered schools exceeds the maximum capacity, schools will be placed on a waiting list.
- Schools must confirm how many students they would like to bring to the Festival by Thursday 26 October 2023. If possible, please provide this information before this date.
- If a registered school wishes to withdraw from this competition, they must confirm before Thursday 26 October 2023. To cancel a booking, please notify students@cobis.org.uk.

Finance

- Schools will be invoiced directly for places booked, not parents or guardians.
- Schools must pay the deposit and balance in a timely manner, in accordance with the timeline specified on all invoices.
 - The non-refundable deposit invoice of £319 per school will be issued by British School of Bahrain during the week commencing 29 October 2023 and must be paid by Monday 27 November 2023.
 - The balance invoice will be raised during the week commencing 4 December 2023.

Travel and Accommodation

- Schools must not make any arrangements to travel to or stay in Bahrain until their place has been formally confirmed by COBIS and the host school.
- Schools must take out the appropriate insurance policies in order to attend the competition; the policy should include travel, medical and cancellation insurance as well as anything else as required by your school or region.

Cancellation

- COBIS and the host school reserve the right to cancel this event if insufficient bookings are received, or if travel to the host country becomes inadvisable.
- Schools must take out the appropriate insurance policies in order to attend this competition; the policy should include cancellation, travel and medical insurance as well as anything else as required by your school or region.

COBIS Code of Conduct

By participating in a COBIS Student Event, individuals agree to abide by the Code of Conduct as outlined below. Participants who exhibit any behaviour that contravenes this may be immediately removed from the event in question and may be suspended from future COBIS events. Students:

- Demonstrate empathy, tolerance, respect, and kindness towards others.
- Be respectful of differing opinions, viewpoints, experiences, and cultural sensitivities.
- Be considerate and respectful to all participants, attendees, hosts, officials and COBIS staff.
- Do not engage in unacceptable behaviour, including but not limited to demeaning, discriminatory, or harassing behaviour, materials, or speech, whether in-person or online.
- Take part for enjoyment and strive for personal excellence.
- Graciously accept constructive feedback
- Compete by the competition conditions and rules.
- Accept responsibility and apologising to those affected by our mistakes, and learning from the experience
- Learn to value honest effort, skilled performance and improvement.
- Cooperate with the officials, teachers, and teammates (if applicable).
- Do not argue with the officials' decisions.

In the case of team events:

- Work hard for the team as well as for yourself.
- Treat all teammates and opponents with kindness and respect.

Data Sharing and Processing

- In order to administer this event, COBIS/the host school will collect student names, ages, dietary requirements, and access requirements, as well as passport details if required for visa support letters. Please ensure that you have obtained the correct consent from pupils or guardians when providing this information. COBIS may ask for evidence of this consent.
- COBIS will also collect lead teacher, head teacher and finance names and contact details. This data will be shared with the host school for the administration of the event. COBIS and the host school have a data sharing agreement in place to protect the transfer of this information. This information will not be passed by COBIS to any other parties.

- COBIS will retain data and information in line with their [Privacy Policy](#). The host school will retain data and information in line with their [Data Protection Policy](#).

Should your school not adhere to these terms and conditions, your membership with COBIS may be subject to repercussions as determined by the COBIS Board.
