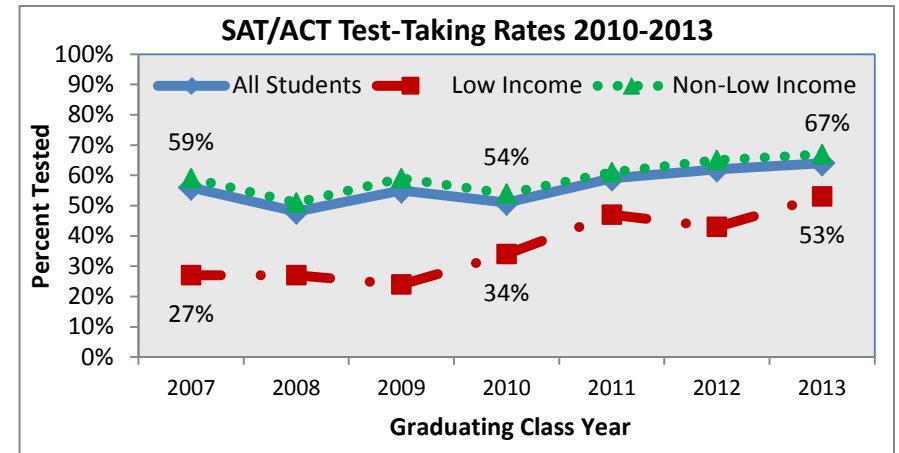
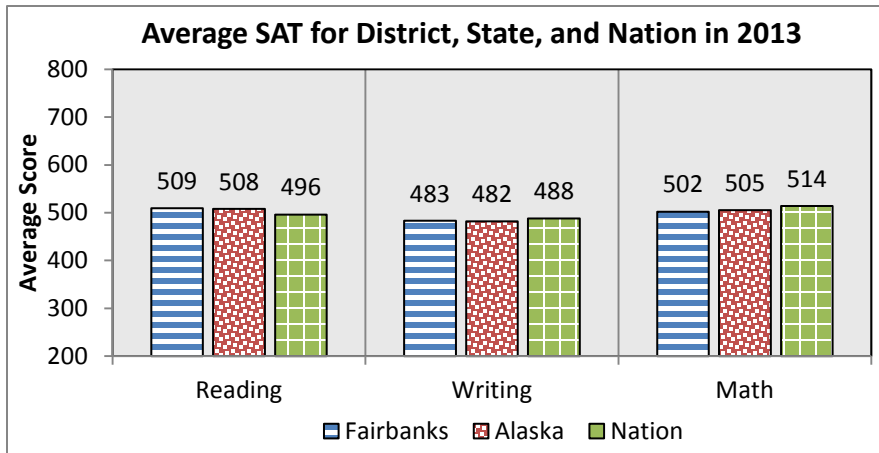
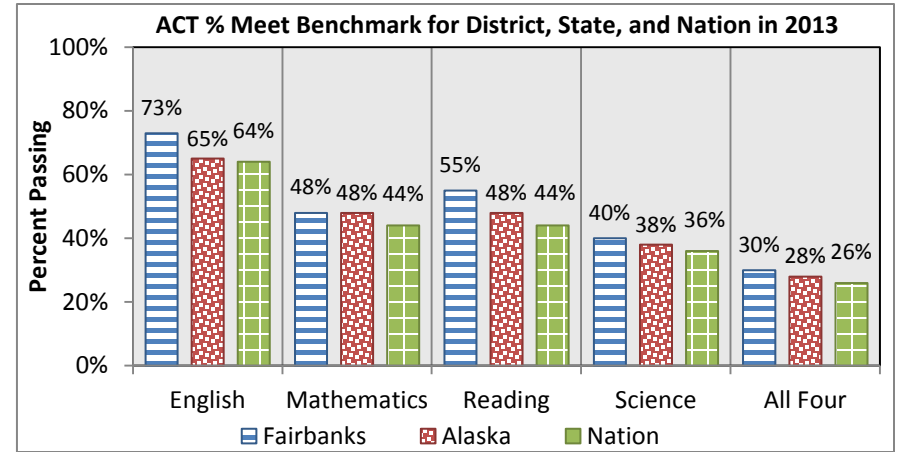
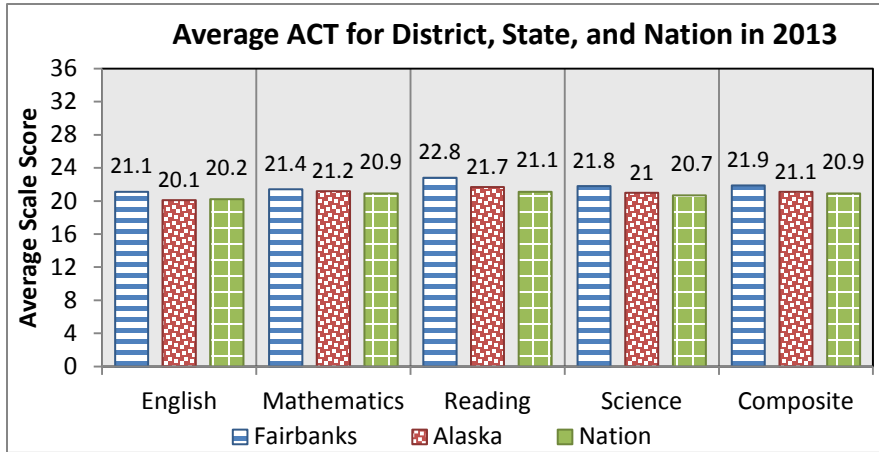


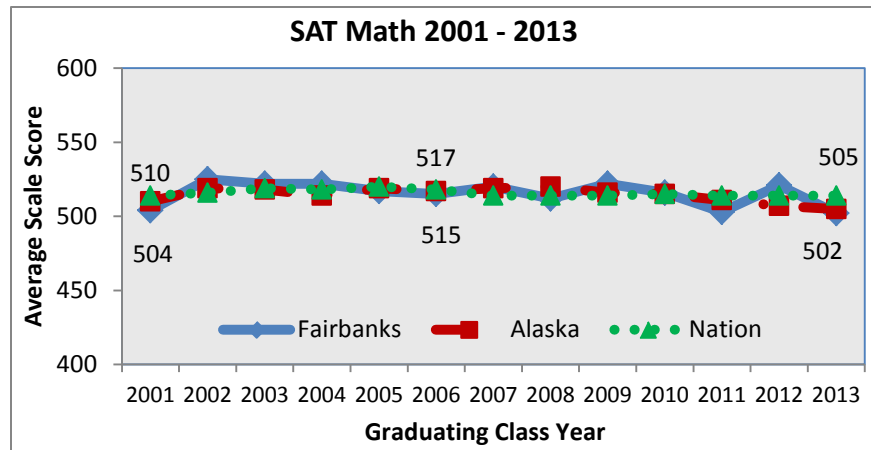
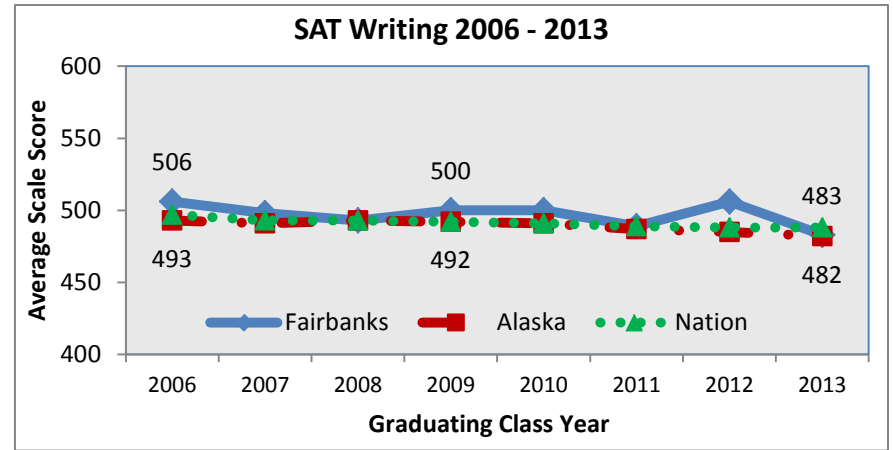
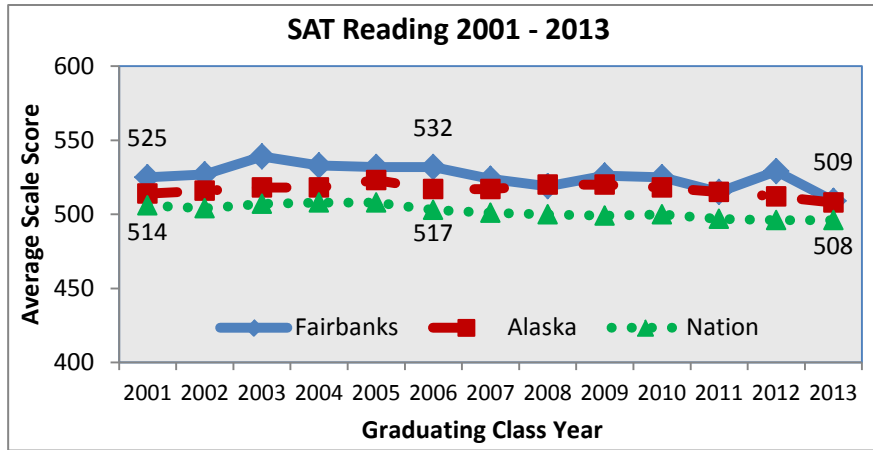
# Fairbanks North Star Borough School District SAT/ACT/AP Dashboard



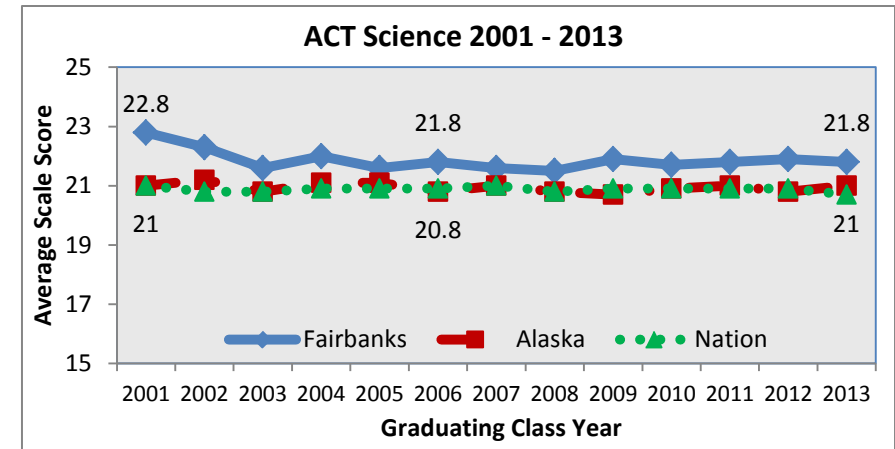
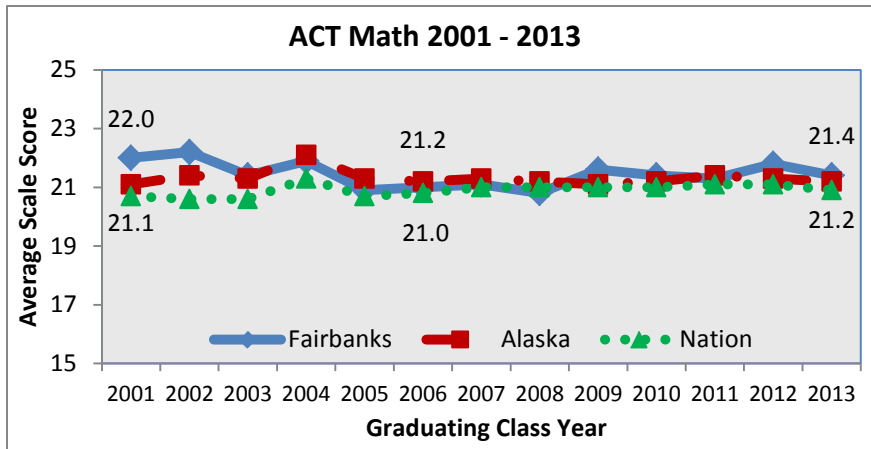
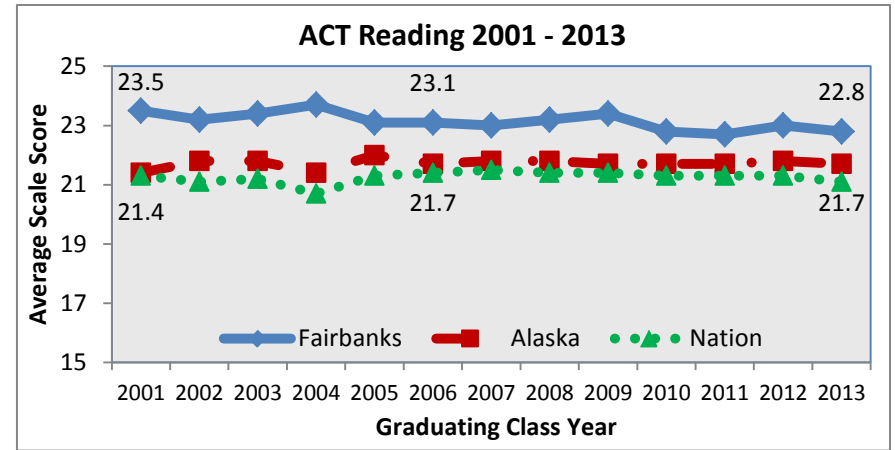
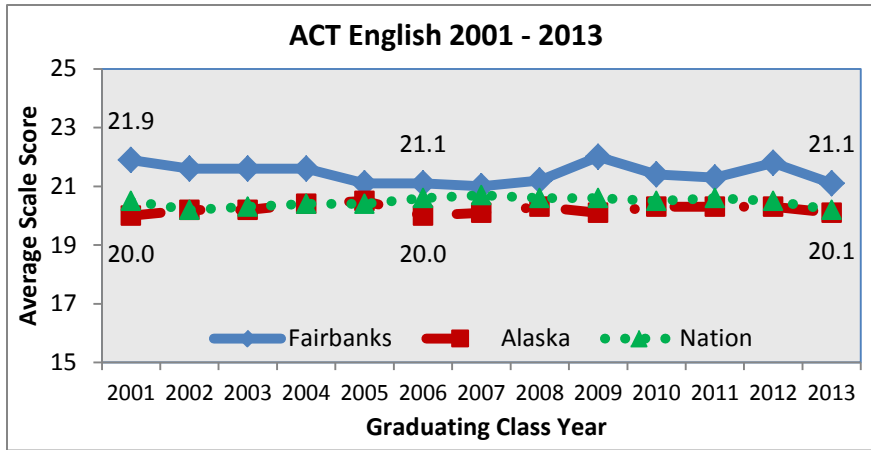
- With few exceptions, district results are above the state and nation
- Low Income test-taking rates almost doubled over the last 7 years

ACT = American College Testing – scores range from 1-36; Meeting an ACT Benchmark is acquiring a score which indicates a 50% chance of obtaining a B or higher in the corresponding credit bearing college course or 75% chance of obtaining a C or higher. SAT = Scholastic Achievement Test – scores range from 200-800

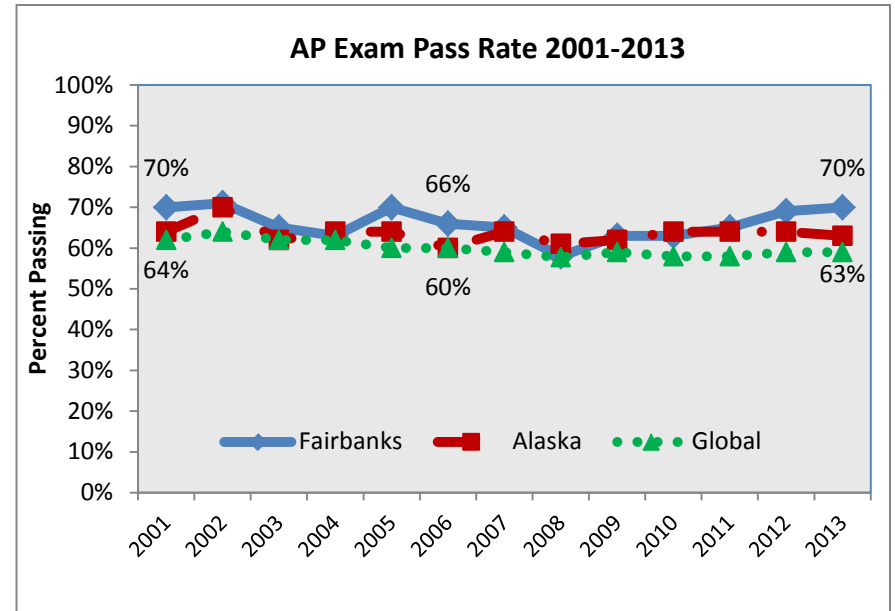
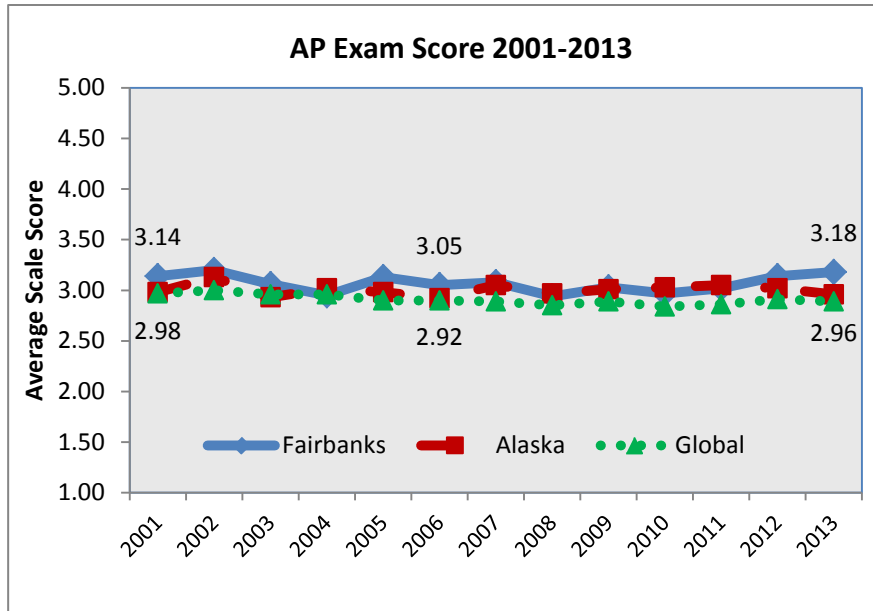
# Fairbanks North Star Borough School District SAT/ACT/AP Dashboard



- District results tend to be above the state and nation in Reading and Writing
- Class of 2013 showed lower average performance than previous years, but more students took the test



- District results tend to be above the state and nation in English, Reading, and Science
- The number of students tested is the highest it has ever been



- In 2012-2013, 70% of AP exams taken by district students received scores of 3 or higher
- In most years, the average AP exam score for district students is above “passing”
- District results tend to be above statewide and global results
