1210 Education Agency Relations Goals

The Board will support and cooperate with the educational endeavors of other institutions whose goals are compatible with those of the district.

In these relationships, the superintendent will strive to stand as a partner and colleague.

1220 Relations with Other Schools and School Districts

The superintendent will cooperate, with the concurrence of the Board, with other school districts and with other local, state, and regional agencies and organizations in matters of common concern and benefit.

1221 Shared Services

The superintendent, with Board approval, may agree to provide services for private and parochial school students.

1230 Relations with Post-Secondary Educational Institutions

The Board desires that staff and students of the district benefit from resources provided by the colleges and universities of the area. The district may establish and maintain cooperative working relationships with post-secondary educational institutions in the area.

1231 Student Teaching and Internships

The district has the responsibility for cooperating with teacher training institutions in the placement of student teachers and interns. The superintendent shall prepare, together with the teacher training institution, regulations governing the placement of student teachers and interns.

1240 Professional Visitors

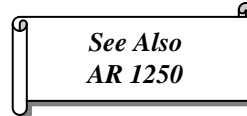


## 1250 Research in Schools

**Purpose:** Instructional time is valuable. Research that does not support the mission of the school district will not be approved.

The superintendent shall establish and maintain a process to screen all research in the schools in order to make sure it furthers the mission of the district, is of the highest quality, does not violate the rights of any persons involved, and does not take time away from instructional activities.

### 1250.1 Notice of and Consent to Surveys

The Fairbanks North Star Borough School District shall not require students to submit to a survey concerning certain personal issues without prior written consent of the parent, in compliance with the Protection of Pupil Rights Amendment (PPRA) (20 U.S.C. 1232h), as well as Alaska Statute 14.03.110.

Prior written consent will be required when the survey inquires into personal or private family affairs of the student that are not a matter of public record or subject to public observation, including but not limited to the following personal issues:

- (1) political affiliations;
- (2) mental and psychological problems potentially embarrassing to the student or his family;
- (3) sex behavior and attitudes;
- (4) illegal, anti-social, self-incriminating, and demeaning behavior;
- (5) critical appraisals of other individuals with whom respondents have close family relationships;
- (6) legally recognized privileged or analogous relationships, such as those of lawyers, physicians, and ministers;
- (7) religious practices, affiliations, or beliefs of the student or student's parent; or
- (8) income (other than that required by law to determine eligibility for participation in a program or for receiving financial assistance under such program).
