What is Title I?

SZES identified as a Title I school as part of the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). Title I is designed to support state and local school reform efforts tied to the challenging state academic standards to improve teaching and learning for students. What is it?

SZES values the contributions and involvement of our parents in order to establish an equal partnership for the common goal of improving student achievement. This plan describes the different ways that SZES will encourage and support parent engagement. How is it revised?

SZES welcomes parent input and comments at any time regarding this plan. All parent feedback will be used to revise the plan for the next school year. The plan is posted on our school website for parents to view and feedback is welcome throughout the year. We also distribute an annual survey online. A note will be sent to parents via students that has the survey link and information about how they can request a paper copy of the survey.

Who is it for?

All students and their families are encouraged and invited to fully participate in the opportunities described in this plan. SZES will provide full opportunity for the participation of parents with limited English, parents with disabilities, and parents of migratory children. Residential facilities in the school attendance area are included in any parent involvement correspondence and activities as well.

Where is it available?

At the beginning of the school year by November 1, the plan is distributed to all students. Parents can also retrieve a copy of the Family Engagement Plan from the school's front office, the Parent Resource Center, the school website, and the Bulloch County Board of Education.

The compact will be reviewed and updated annually based on feedback from parents, students and teachers received throughout the school year.

SZES Supports Achievement!

SZES will take the following measures to promote and support parents as an important foundation of the school in order to strengthen the school and reach our goals. We will:

- Communicate with all families and the community on a regular basis regarding school-wide events and activities via call outs, email, and social media.
- Conduct staff development annually on parent involvement practices and effective strategies for staff to communicate and build partnerships with parents.
- Partner with LCMS to share information about family engagement opportunities that will help prepare parents and their children for a smooth transition to middle school.
- Share information in English and Spanish for parents to understand the school's academic standards and assessments as well as the ways parents can monitor their child's progress and work with educators.
- Work with parents to develop relevant trainings and presentations to educate them on how to help their child achieve academic success.
- Listen and respond to parents' requests for additional educational support.
- Maintain a Parent Resource Room to help parents establish home learning environments.

2023-2024 District Graduation Goal

Bulloch County Schools will increase its graduation rate from 83.5% in 2019-2020 to 90% by 2023-2024.

2023-2024 District Goals

1. Bulloch County Schools will increase the percentage of 8th grade students scoring at proficient or distinguished on the Spring ELA GMAS End-of-Grade assessment from 41% in Spring 2021 to 56% by Spring 2024.
2. Bulloch County Schools will increase the percentage of 9th grade students scoring at proficient or distinguished on the Spring American Lit EOC assessment from 22% in Spring 2021 to 37% by Spring 2024.
3. Bulloch County Schools will increase the percentage of students in grades 3-8 scoring at the proficient or distinguished Level on the Spring Math GMAS assessment from 31.9% in Spring 2021 to 50.0% by Spring 2024.
4. Bulloch County Schools will increase the percentage of students taking Algebra I scoring at the Proficient or Distinguished Level on the GMAS end-of-course assessment from 28.4% in 2021 to 50.0% by 2024.

2023-2024 School Improvement Goals

1. Sallie Zetterower Elementary will increase its CCRPI ELA weighted proficiency rate for all students by 5% annually from 55.4% in 2022 to 57.6% in 2023; to 59.7% in 2024; to 61.7% in 2025.
2. Sallie Zetterower Elementary will increase its CCRPI Math weighted proficiency rate for all students by 5% annually from 54.9% in 2023 to 57.2% in 2024; to 59.3% in 2025; to 61.3% in 2026.
