Ignite!!!**

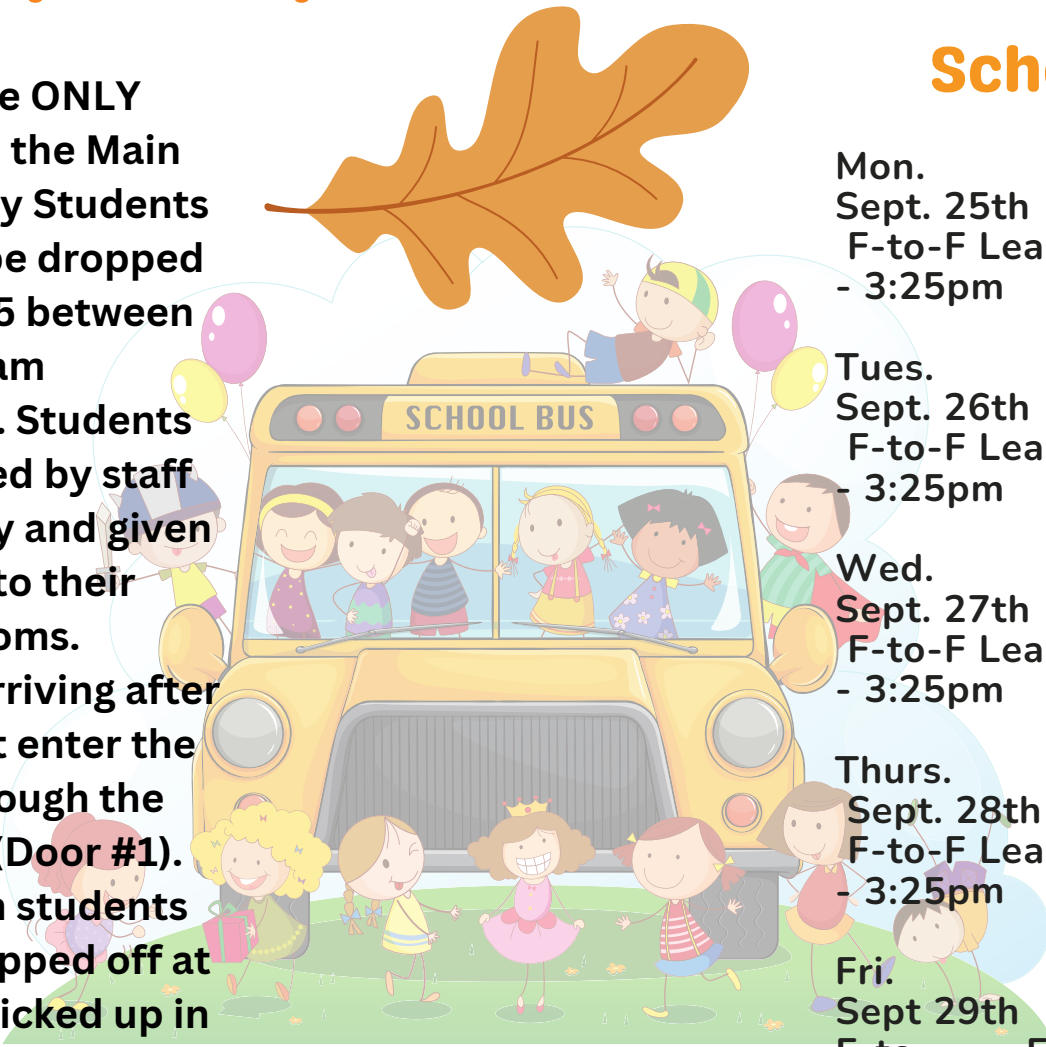

- **After School Tutoring should be starting no later than the last week of September-More Info to come!**

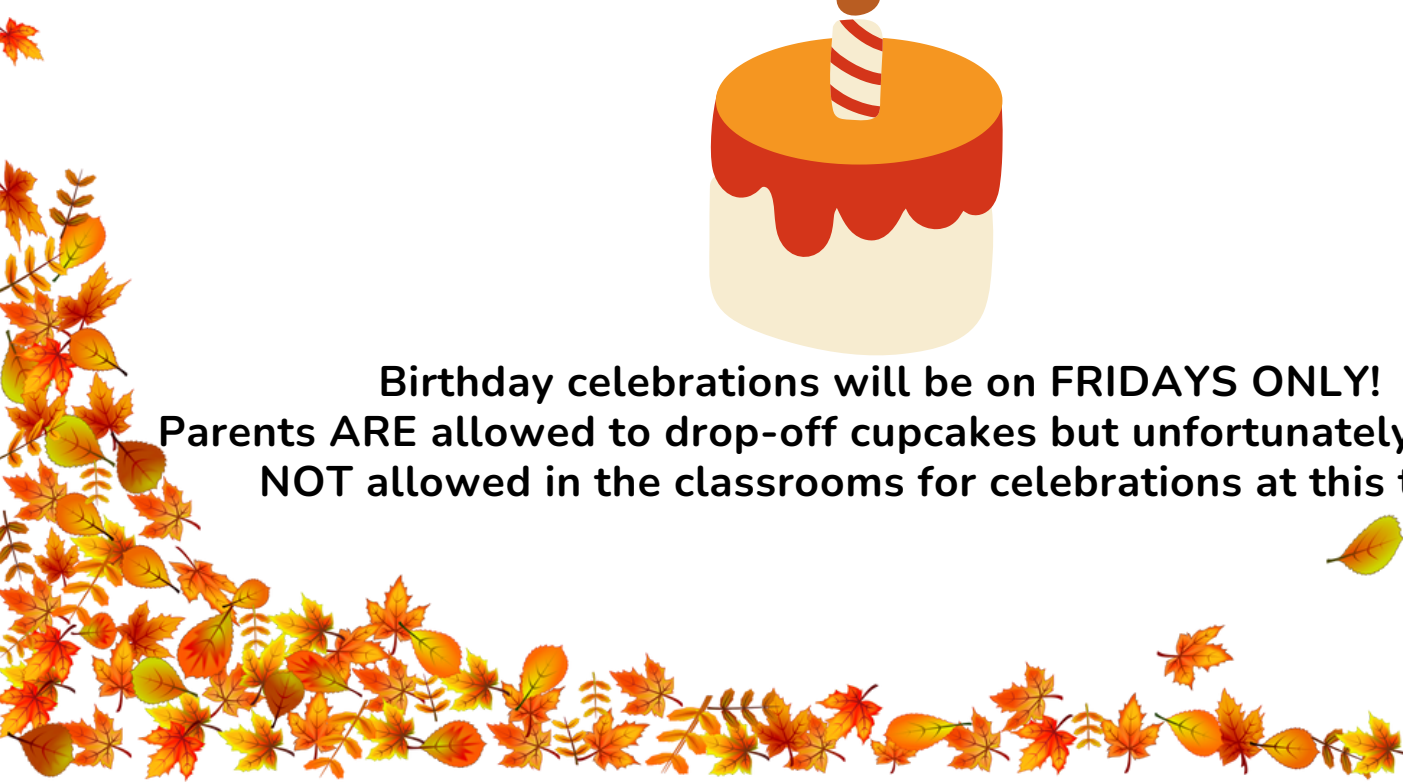
