MESSY BROWNIES FOR OCTOBER BY: RUBY RAMIREZ

For the Brownie layer

- 10 tablespoons unsalted butter
- 1 1/4 cups white sugar
- 3/4 cup cocoa powder
- 1/2 teaspoons kosher salt
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 2 large eggs
- 1/2 cup flour

For the Oreo Layer

- one package of Oreos

For the cookie dough layer

- 1/2 cup unsalted butter (at room temp)
- 1/4 cup brown sugar
- 3/4 cup white sugar
- 1 egg
- 1 1/4 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 1 1/4 cups flour
- 1/2 teaspoons salt
- 1/2 teaspoons baking soda
- 1/2 teaspoons baking powder
- 1 cup semi-sweet chocolate chips



- Pre-heat the oven to 350 degrees F.
- Line the bottom of a 9x9 baking pan with tin foil and then spray the tin foil with a layer of baking spray.
- Layer the cookie dough on the bottom of a 9x9 baking pan, pressing down to form the bottom of the slatty brownies.
- Layer as many Oreos that will fit on top of the cookie dough. No need to overlap. One single layer will do.
- Pour the brownie batter on top of the oreo layer and make sure it's evenly layers on top.
- Bake for 30-40 minutes. Test with a knife to see if the center is done. If the knife comes out clean, let the brownies rest for at least 2 hours before serving. If the knife comes out with batter still on it, allow the brownies to bake about 5 minutes more
- . Slice and serve.
