Subject: Information Security Breach and Notification

The District is required under the New York State Technology Law to notify affected individuals when there has been or is reasonably believed to have been an unauthorized acquisition of computerized data which compromises the security, confidentiality or integrity of individual’s private information in compliance, defined by State law to include:

1. Social security number;
2. Driver’s license number or non-driver identification card number;
or
3. Account number, credit or debit card number, in combination with any required security code, access code, or password, which would permit access to an individual’s financial account.

“*Private information*” does not include publicly available information that is lawfully made available to the general public from federal, state or local government records.

The Superintendent of Schools, or his/her designee(s) will comply with the provisions of the State Technology Law as applicable to school districts.
