**Subject: Transportation Program**

The Williamson Central School District includes appropriation in its proposed annual budget for the following:

- a) Transportation between home and school for all children attending UPK through Grade 12 who live not more than fifteen miles from the public school they legally attend, with no minimum distance required.
- b) Transportation to a non-public school for any child living not more than fifteen miles from such school. The District shall designate one or more pickup points for children living within the Williamson Central School District but more than fifteen miles from the non-public school they wish to attend if transportation is being provided to that school for others residing within the fifteen mile limit. The District shall provide transportation between the designated pickup point and the non-public school attended and may use District transportation between home and designated pickup point providing there is room on the bus.
- c)

Any change in the student transportation requirements of the Education Law are deemed automatically incorporated in this policy.
