

Our Master Plan Vision Must:

- 1. Provide a **district-wide solution**, even though it will need to be phased
- 2. Maintain **buildings in communities** that have existing buildings
- 3. Cause the **least disruption** to our students
- 4. Include <u>'grade-banded'</u> elementary schools to maintain <u>academic equity</u>
- 5. Incorporate Career Tech and Partnerships
- 6. Address the Middle School and our oldest primary buildings in the first phase
- 7. Consider future growth while balancing **fiscal responsibility**
- 8. <u>No new swing space</u> (temporary space used for phasing) during construction
- **9.** Not require land acquisition (no new property needed to be purchased)





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
