We're excited to be returning to Warm Beach for Camp Phoenix 2023! Please review the information below and complete the following items by **Friday, September 29**.

- Optional [Dietary Restrictions](#) to list your student's dietary restrictions
- [Medical Authorization Form](#) required if your student needs medication at camp

What days do high school students attend camp? What about middle school?

In summary, high school students will attend camp Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday; middle school students will attend Thursday and Friday. A detailed draft itinerary is attached to this message.

Wednesday, October 4

- Grades 6-8 attend classes 7:50 - 1:15 on campus at ICS.
- Grades 9-12 arrive at school with their camp gear by 7:30 and depart for camp at 8:00.

Thursday, October 5

- Grades 6-8 arrive at school with their camp gear by 7:30 and depart for camp at 8:00.
- Grades 9-12 begin their day at camp.

Friday, October 6

- Students arrive for parent pick-up at ICS at approximately 2:30.

How do I pay for camp?

Payment can be paid in person or online:

- In person at the ICS main office: credit card, cash, or check (payable to International Community School)
- Online via the [LWSD Payment Portal](#) (credit cards only)

If your student needs the camp fee waived, please complete a confidential [Fee Waiver Form](#) by September 29.

What should my student bring?

- Closed toed shoes
- Appropriate outdoor clothing - check the weather
- Sleeping bag
- Pillow
- Flashlight
- Toiletries as needed

Please do NOT bring valuables of any kind, electronics, or anything not permitted on school campus.

What if my student needs to take medication?

Students who will be taking medications, including self-carry over the counter and supplements, must return a [Medical Authorization Form](#) signed by the parent/guardian AND your healthcare provider. Medication must be in the original prescription bottle and properly labeled with the name of the student, name of medication, dosage, time the medication is to be given, expiration date, name of the health care provider and the date the prescription was filled. All over-the-counter medication and supplements need to be labelled with the student's name, name of medication, dosage, and time the medication is to be given. What if my student has dietary restrictions?

The Warm Beach kitchens are prepared to handle a variety of food restrictions. If your student has dietary restrictions, please complete the [Dietary Restrictions Form](#).

What if my student does not go to camp?

We understand that there are many reasons why a student would not be able to go to camp. In the event that your student does not attend camp, please inform the school attendance office of your student's absence.

Is COVID-19 still a concern?

Students should stay home from camp if they are too sick for school. Staying home protects other students and staff from any potential illness, not just COVID-19. The district's Too Sick for School tool is located on the Health Services tab of the district website. If you are

ever unsure if your student should come to school, please give us a call and we can help you through the process. Although there are no specific changes to our guidance during camp, we strongly recommend students continue practicing good hygiene. If your student becomes ill or displays any COVID-19 symptoms, we will contact you to come pick up your student from camp.
