DISCIPLINE AND CLASSROOM MANAGEMENT TECHNIQUES

REQUIRED LAW THAT POLICY MEETS (IF APPLICABLE)

(2)(i) 7 Selection and implementation of discipline and classroom management techniques as a part of a comprehensive school safety plan, including responsibilities of the student, parent, teacher, counselor, and principal.

(5)(a) School administrators, teachers, or other school personnel may immediately remove or cause to be removed threatening or violent students from a classroom setting or from the district transportation system pending any further disciplinary action that may occur. Each board of education shall adopt a policy to assure the implementation of this section and to assure the safety of the students and staff.

POLICY

1. The council policy shall adhere to the rights and responsibilities of students as stated by the Fayette County School Board policy and the Student Code of Conduct.
2. The administration shall adopt and annually review a school-wide discipline plan that utilizes both positive reinforcement and tiered consequences as a means to curb student misbehavior.
3. The school-wide discipline plan will be given to all staff members annually.
4. Any student who is assigned to SAFE, or in-school suspension, shall be ineligible to participate in any after-school activity the day served, with the exception of Extended School Services and after school tutoring, unless otherwise noted by the administration.
