WHY TAKE FRENCH COURSES AT MORTON?

French I is a yearlong, studentcentered course that will focus on learning to read, write, speak and listen in French. This course is for students who are interested in learning French for the first time. Students will be able to greet each other, order food, talk about activities that they enjoy in the past and present. In this course, students will learn about a variety of cultures while learning key vocabulary and grammar. Students will earn one extra elective credit for this course.

AP French courses are available for all students. When students do well in this course and score a 3 or higher on the exam, they can earn college credit while still in high school. They can also earn the Seal of Biliteracy upon graduation from high school.
