



**Q1:**

- a. Is TBP having drawings/specs created? I see on "2.1 - Scope of work" it states "Contractor must provide services of an engineer licensed by the Texas Board of Professional Engineers."
- b. Do you want us to provide that engineering cost in our proposal or do you want to work with them separately from us?

**A:**

TBP does not have engineered specs or drawings produced for this job. If the contractor plans on making any type of structural changes, then the contractor would need the engineered drawings to be included with their proposal. If no structural changes are planned, then contractor can proceed with proposal submittal.

**Q2:**

On the questionnaire it asks for each individual proposed to work. Do you want a list of all the guys?

**A:**

If you are sub-contracting the job out, you are required to disclose the owner and the name of the point contact person. If they work for your company, you don't have to disclose but TBP can request a list from the awarded vendor throughout the duration of the job.

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
