



School Health Advisory Council Special Meeting Minutes  
Meeting start time – 6:06 p.m.

**Opening Statements:**

- Meeting called to order by Araceli, SHAC Coordinator
- Prior meeting minutes were presented and approved:
  - All prior meeting minutes approved at 6:14

**Welcome-What is SHAC:**

- Round Table Introductions were performed:
  - Present members introduced themselves and provided their affiliation with the district.
- The SHAC definition and purpose was provided.
- SHAC roles were described:
  - Chair, Co-Chair, and Secretary roles were described:
    - Nominations and voting will need to take place during a SHAC meeting with enough members to vote.
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**Senate Bill 9 Requirements/ Health TEKS Curriculum Recommendations:**

- For 2022-2023, SHAC must continue to recommend curriculum material to the District Board that aligned with the new Health TEKS, and legislation changes per the State of Texas.
- Senate Bill 9: Requires schools to provide education on prevention related to child abuse, family violence, dating violence, and human trafficking. The focus is on a prevention program and identification/recognition of potential indicators of the above subjects.
- Nurse Araceli submitted a Board resolution that was approved on October 27<sup>th</sup> that allows SHAC to convene and discuss materials for instruction relating to the Prevention of Child Abuse, Family Violence, Dating Violence, and Sex Trafficking.
  - SHAC will be holding at least two public meetings before presenting a curriculum recommendation to the Board.
- KISD already has curriculum programs that contain the above materials and would be compliant with Senate Bill 9 if chosen:
  - Play it Safe and Second Step are programs that are already used for other curriculum materials, that could also be used for the instructions of child abuse, family violence, dating violence, and education regarding human trafficking.
- Nurse Araceli will be working on getting an approval to hold at least one Teams meeting to discuss the above with all the SHAC members.



### **Unassigned Medication for the Kennedale ISD:**

- The current SHAC members voted at 6:25 p.m. to proceed with Nurse Araceli's proposed plan to implement emergency medication kits for the district. The emergency medications kits would be classified as "unassigned medication"; meaning that any one could utilize the medication in the event of an emergency. The two types of medications are Epi-Pens and Narcan.
  - The initiative to implement the mentioned medication is a preventative initiative.
  - Epi- Pens can be utilized in the event of an anaphylactic (allergic) reaction.
    - If approved, each campus would have the appropriate medication.
  - Narcan spray is an opioid antagonist that can be used as a life saving measure.

### **Closing Remarks/Q&A:**

- Our high school students and parents would like to discuss the possibility of having the vending machines open other than during passing periods.
  - Nurse Araceli to reach out to our Nutrition Director to ask about current legislations and/or KISD policies and rules in regards to only having the vending machines open during passing periods.
- Officer nominations and voting need to take place when there are more members present.
