TOPS:

BOTTOMS: Girls: Skirts and dresses should be no more than 5 inches above Chino, twill, or corduroy pants and shorts (solid color, plaid, • the top of the knee. or pattern) Dresses must have sleeves with a modest neckline. Colored denim (No blue jeans may be worn Monday-Thursday.) Shorts must have a 7-inch or more inseam. • **OUTERWEAR:** Hoodies, jackets, sweatshirts, ³/₄ zip pullovers, or fleeces must be FCS Spirit Wear or solid school colors (navy blue, gray, white and any non-FCS logos/branding must be smaller than a half-dollar coin). FCS Spirit Wear T-shirts will be allowed under outerwear, Monday-Thursday. If outerwear is removed, students must meet the dress code requirements for tops. Ex. For boys, a collared shirt. Once high school seniors have been accepted to college, they may wear that college's outerwear Monday-Friday. FOOTWEAR: Athletic shoes, loafers, dress shoes, boots Specific shoe styles may be required for certain PE/Elective classes. Middle and High School students may wear leather and athletic sandals (Birkenstocks, Chacos, Tevas, etc.). HAIR/ACCESSORIES: Girls: Bovs: Hair color must be a natural color and non-distracting. T-shirts and outerwear that fall into the following categories: Sharp Top, Camp Highland, Rock Eagle, Field Day, Field Trips, • Young Life, and Christian-themed shirts are also considered approved Spirit Wear. College sweatshirts (Seniors Only) • ATHLETIC WEAR: Occasionally the school will allow events where athletic wear is allowed (i.e. Retreat or Field Day).
