FACILITIES

Lake Mary Preparatory School opened in August of 1999. The school is located on 48 acres and consists of a 45,000 square foot building containing classrooms, science laboratories, computer labs, makerspace rooms, art studios, band rooms, drama/dance room, fully-equipped weight room, regulation-sized gymnasium, performance stage, lunchrooms, cafe, campus store, and administrative offices. Additionally, a 22,000 square foot Lower School building and an athletic complex, including football and baseball fields, a track, and a five-court tennis complex round out the school's campus.

COMMUNITY

Lake Mary Preparatory School is located in a suburban residential area in Seminole County, 14 miles north of Orlando. The City of Lake Mary is a rapidly growing community with a current population of 17,333. Located 3 miles east of a major high-tech corridor, chief employers in the area include AAA International Headquarters, AT&T, Deloitte Consulting, Duke Energy, FARO Technologies, Hilton Hotels, Mitsubishi Power Systems, and Verizon.

STUDENT BODY: 530

Lower School 220; Middle School 125; Upper School 185. Lake Mary Preparatory School has a culturally and economically diverse population. The majority of LMP's day students reside in the Central Florida area. LMP's international students make up 15% of the overall student body population. In total, the student population encompasses 20 nationalities.

FACULTY

LMP employs 52 teaching faculty, 32 who teach at the upper school level and 41% hold advanced degrees and 4 hold doctorates in their subject areas.


OUR SCHOOL COMMUNITY
