BE SUPPORTED

Students meet with their **Faculty Advisors** every day to ensure everyone remains informed, engaged and successful. Altamont's Student Support Team meets weekly to identify and assist students and families who need additional support.

Altamont's College Counseling Office helps students identify and research higher education options, directs academic advising and course selection, hosts college application workshops for students and parents, leads a weeklong college tour for juniors, and hosts more than 65 college representatives at Altamont each year.

The Student Assistance Counseling Office maintains extensive resources to support student mental health, including two full-time counselors, a learning specialist, individual meetings, guides to difficult conversations, and a parent/counselor book club.




TAILORED TUITION

At Altamont, basic tuition covers many things that are additional costs at other schools, including extended care from 7:15 a.m. to 4:50 p.m., healthy lunches, yearbook, and more. But, we understand that the cost of an exceptional independent school education requires a financial commitment from your family. With Tailored Tuition, an Altamont education is more affordable than you might think. Approximately 38% of our current families pay reduced tuition.

Tailored Tuition takes into account each family's unique income and expense portfolio and adjusts tuition accordingly. Applicants submit information for a confidential financial assessment. Following that analysis, a tuition recommendation is made and reviewed by our admissions team.

Our goal is to put an Altamont education within reach of all families who want exceptional academic and extracurricular opportunities for their children.
