Transportation Safety Complaints & Reporting

The Superintendent of Schools shall:

1. Develop procedures for reporting all complaints relative to school transportation safety, including complaints about bus drivers.
2. Maintain a written record of all complaints relative to school transportation safety.
3. Annually, within thirty (30) days after the end of the school year, provide the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles with a copy of the written record of transportation safety complaints received for the previous twelve-month period.
4. Submit a written report of the circumstances of any accident within the Superintendent's jurisdiction and knowledge involving a motor vehicle and any pedestrian who is a student which occurs at a designated school bus stop or in the immediate vicinity thereof to the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles within ten (10) days.
5. Regularly review the complaints received or accidents reported between motor vehicles and district students with the Board of Education.
