


#### Medical Forensics

- Another new elective at SLCSE this year is Medical Forensics. Juniors and Seniors apply their Chemistry, Biology, Physics learning and deductive reasoning skills to solve forensic mysteries. So far students, have learned how to document crime scenes, collect and analyze trace evidence. It's about to get more gruesome as we learn how to analyze blood splatter patterns and deduce time of death based on decomposition rates under different environments.
- The class can be applied towards CTE (career and technical education) credits or an Applied Science credit.
